Abstract

The EMBL is one of the leading basic research organizations for molecular biology. About 90 research groups work in the fields of cell biology, developmental biology, gene expression, structural biology and computational biology distributed over 5 European sites. In several core facilities, analytical methods and services are offered for the different research groups like the Advanced Light Microscopy and the Electron Microscopy core facility. Integrated facilities for structural biology are offered to the scientific community at the Hamburg and Grenoble sites that are located in direct vicinity to synchrotron radiation sources, PETRA III and the ESRF.
