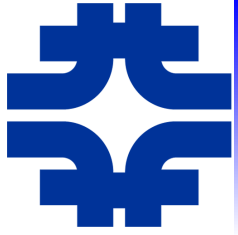


Update on the WLCG Squid Monitoring Task Force

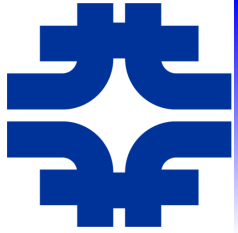

Much progress made

- Agreeing to limit the scope of the task force to exclude proxy discovery helped greatly
- We were able to resolve almost all the questions in one meeting
- The task force has no plans to meet again



Agreements

- Squid services will be registered as public DNS names in GOCDDB & OIM, without distinguishing application
 - Multiple services per site supported
- Store differences for monitoring on monitoring server, maintained manually but designed so ATLAS could generate from AGIS data in the future
- Add SAM/SUM per-Squid service test based on responses to MRTG on monitoring server
- Add SAM/SUM per-Squid service test based on hits to Frontier/CVMFS reverse-proxy Squids **not** through site Squid service, based on awstats on monitoring server
 - ATLAS operations is not planning to use this
