


Call for 2014 Young Scientist Prize nominations

- Candidates for the prize should have a maximum of 8 years of research experience (excluding career interruptions) following the PhD.
- Nominations should consist of a minimum of two letters explaining the nominee's qualifications and scientific achievements, a complete CV and a list of publications.
- Nomination materials should be sent by electronic mail to the C11 Commission Chair Hiroaki Aihara IUPAP-YSP@hep.phys.s.u-tokyo.ac.jp before March 1, 2014.
