Some information concerning your account

if you need more disk space :

- homedir space/workspace account :

- secondary account : <http://cern.ch/account>

- yet more space (on AFS) : ask elena

web pages

- home web pages can be created via

<http://cern.ch/web>

- it is strongly recommend that you store files on the CERN server and not on your local home-directory (specially for anything that is of general interest as conferences, projects ...)

Batch computing

- The TH group has access to about 1000 cores in the lxbatch system (can be up to 5000, average 1400) Easy to use, generally good availability (90-95%)

mathematica

- CERN provides to TH staff and fellows a limited number of mathematica home licenses : if you need it, please ask elena as she has to sign the form !
- ask only if you are going to use it !

hepsoft and HEP software

- PH/SFT provides the access to some HEP and other software (boost, graphviz, fastjet, HepMC, ROOT ...) and MC generators (agile, lhpdf, rivet, sherpa ...) in

- for an easy use of them hepsoft is provided : a collection of those tools requested by TH :

`/afs/cern.ch/sw/lcg/hepsoft`

- in order for it to be useful, elena needs to know which software/version you need
- you just need to source a setup file to use it
- I propose that people that need to use these programs subscribe to the e-group :

MAC software

- CERN provides also some software for MAC machines such as mathematica binaries, Microsoft Office2011, Antivirus ...
- FINDER -> GO -> Connect to server :

Windows

- Software for Windows machines is provided by CERN via CDS but you will need to re-install your PC with the CERN version of Windows
