 - ⇒ Council may reflect on them to consolidate the organisational structure related the Strategy

- Brochure for neither explaining particle physics nor for the Strategy, but it **explains the social relevance of particle physics** to the politicians and general public prepared by the Communication Group.
- Distributed in this occasion of the official ceremonial adoption of the European Strategy by the CERN Council in Brussels in May 30th.

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 - e^+e^- programme and ILC: Maximise the global opportunities by exploring the European participation in the possible ILC project in Japan. (Probably, we should not be just waiting...)
 - **Neutrinos**: Facilitate a bases at CERN for the needs by the long baseline experiment detector R&D and support strong European participation in the experiment at the US or Japan.
