## **MT** Conversion and Compliance

Information currently on TWiki pages must be moved into official Documentation Guides

Application Guide Top-level migrations, #include's, new classes

**Toolkit Guide** Process, model, cross-section migrations; use of static const vs. G4ThreadLocal; multithread safety

Installation Guide Building and running MT apps; CMake settings; platform/compiler limitations

Ensure interface changes in classes are documented in situ, not just in a separate "MT" chapter

TWiki should be maintained as resource for developers, if requirements change after 10.0 release
