- Longest running experiment at CERN

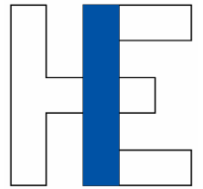
ISOLDE at the PS Booster



The ISOLDE Facility and the HIE-ISOLDE project

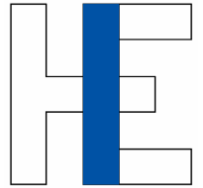

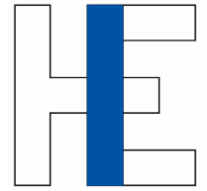
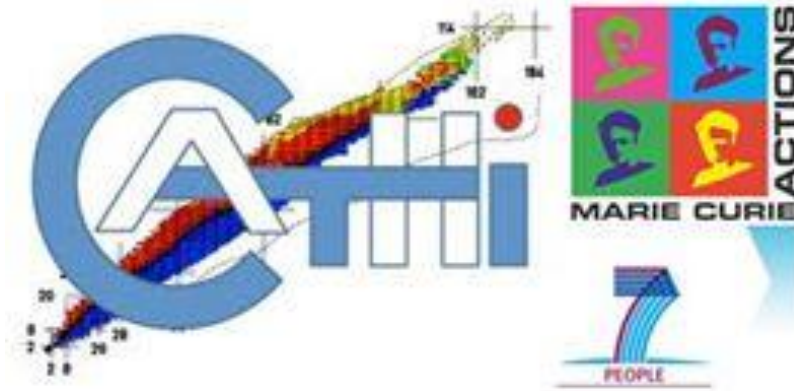
- Opportunity **to present** the technical aspects of the HIE-ISOLDE project to both the ISOLDE and technical communities here at CERN.

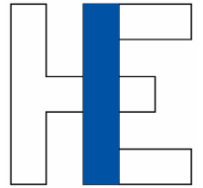
