NEW FOR ICMC CONTRIBUTIONS ONLY Please read carefully

Thank you for your contribution to the upcoming 2013 CEC/ICMC in Anchorage, Alaska. As you know, your abstract has been accepted and incorporated into the Technical Program that is now available on the CEC/ICMC 2013 website at <http://www.cec-icmc.org>.

The first character of the program number, **E** or **M**, represents the conference designation, **E** for the Cryogenic **ENGINEERING** Conference (CEC), **M** for the International Cryogenic **MATERIALS** Conference (ICMC).

NEW FOR ICMC CONTRIBUTIONS ONLY - If you have an ICMC **Poster or Oral Presentation** (paper ID starts with letter M) you are requested to electronically publish your **Posters and Presentations** during the conference and in this way share them with your colleagues. Your oral or poster will be made internet available (<http://indico.cern.ch/event/icmc2013>) at the conference. To make this happen you have to bring a PDF version of your oral or poster to the Speakers Prep room before the oral or poster sessions starts.

On the indico site you can find your and your colleagues contributions in the Timetable of the conference and you are free to view and download the presentations. In this way we offer you a maximum dissemination of your research and a much better exchange of information during the conference.

The conference procedure for collecting ORAL presentations will remain the same, but you are asked to bring not only the usual ppt file but also a PDF version of your oral.

For the collection of POSTER presentations you are now also requested to make a PDF of your poster and bring this copy to the Speakers Prep room before the poster sessions starts. Electronic publication of your **presentation materials** has no affect on the conference proceeding publication of your paper.

Electronic publication of your **ICMC Presentation Materials** at the conference will allow you maximize your conference experience by;

- Providing instant access to data and information that is usually only available for a fleeting moment during the live presentation
- Preserving a shareable record of the hard work put into presentation materials
- Providing an excellent platform for information exchange
