



# Update on SHA-2 readiness

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#### Monitored services

- CREAM VOMS WMS
  - Monitored for SHA-2 support and generating alarms/tickets vs sites in the dashboard
- StoRM
  - Monitored but not raising alarms in the operations dashboard
  - Waiting for StoRM 1.11.2 release date unknown
- dCache
  - Not monitored yet
  - dCache 2.6.5 is being tested in staged rollout
  - dCache 2.2.16 is being released by the PT next Tuesday
- Alarms for StoRM and dCache will be enabled once a SHA-2 enabled version is available in UMD



### Current status of readiness

VOMS	38	18	53%
WMS	42	11	74%
StoRM*	47	42	11%
dCache*	-	79	-

- 57 sites affected from 19 NGIs (CREAM/VOMS/WMS)
  - 3 sites reported issues in upgrading services before end of September

### New timeline

- Current timeline: 1st October 2013
  - <u>EUGridPMA</u> CAs begin to release SHA-2 certificates as default
  - Deadline to upgrade grid services to a SHA-2 enabled version (not strict deadline)
- New timeline proposal:
  - EUGridPMA to keep SHA-1 as the default certificate signature until: 1<sup>st</sup> December 2013 (+ 2 months)
    - To be discussed at the next EUGridPMA meeting
  - Grid services must be SHA-2 compliant by the end of November
    - Strict deadline: downtime/suspension for services not upgraded



## Summary of the next actions

- Turn on monitoring for StoRM and dCache as soon as the new releases are available
- Discuss with EUGridPMA the timeline extension
- Apply the new strict deadline (Dec 1<sup>st</sup>) for the upgrade of non SHA-2 compliant services
