Conclusions on recommendations and actions:

- 1. Update the document on arXiv before the end of September¹, final version (!), add a comment to the introduction/conclusions that this is a current "snapshot" of the situation.
- 2. About Mark's ongoing analysis of HZ with Z decaying to qq; this analysis is also linked to deriving the invisible width ⇔ it was decided that this analysis is not yet sufficiently mature to be included in the release.
- 3. Updates on several individual analyses need to be checked ⇔ action Mark and Philipp
- 4. Check the stars and daggers in Table 4 ⇔ e.g. remove dagger from ttH, possible action on Zgamma ⇔ action Philipp
- 5. Figure 9: add the values of alpha/beta and a reference to the model used. action Mark
- 6. Do we include a reference to the LCD note describing the combined fits? ⇔ yes; leave also the ILC-type fit in the LCD note, adding a disclaimer statement. action Frank
- 7. Calculate the ZZ fusion enhancement with polarization and include it in the paper ⇔ action Philipp
- 8. Send the paper for review to the authors by September ~26th
- 9. Set the deadline for the Higgs studies before the end of December and nominate a few editors for the CLIC Higgs paper \Leftrightarrow action for follow up at the CLICdp 2-day meeting
