Cloud Traceability WG

- One of the proposed action from the September pre-GDB
 - > WG/TF doing a traceability gap analysis in cloud infrastructure
 - Propose realistic, incremental solutions rather than big/strong policies
 - Looking for experts from sites and experiments
- Call for volunteers sent out the day before last GDB
 - > Failed (forgot) to do the call for volunteers before October GDB
- Received #15 answers, showing a real interest
 - > Europe + OSG
 - > Ian Collier proposed to lead the WG
- Discussing startup details: no short-term slot as pre/post-GDB
 - > Will probably start by email/Vidyo discussions on the PoW
 - > Let me/lan know if you would like to join

... Actions in Progress

- Xrootd v4 deployment plans: still to be refined
- IPv6: ATLAS requesting all T1s to join the WG
 - > Also looking for more volunteers for dual stack endpoints
- GStat relevance for WLCG: can sites ignore it?
 - WebDav accesspoints in BDII causing errors
- H2020 VRE proposal in EINFRA-9 (January 14, 2015)
 - > Will include DP effort but wider scope
 - > Work in progress, not clear yet if ti'll converge in time
- EGI collecting cloud requirements from big communities
 - > WLCG is one of them!
 - How? More in EGI presentation today?
