

Update on Drupal Infrastructure

- We are hosting nearly 550 sites
- All sites are running the latest Drupal version 7.23
- Traffic spike on the 8th October (following announcement of the 2013 Nobel Prize in Physics), handled without issues
- Next possible Drupal release 7.24 on November 6th
- Update at CERN within one week of next release + one additional week for production sites to test in a pre-prod environment



Candidates for centrally managed modules:

libraries – locally installed on 73 sites (13% of sites)

ds (display suite) - locally installed on 54 sites (10% of sites)

title – locally installed on 38 sites (7% of sites) – not yet?

We will add these modules as centrally managed with the next Drupal update, if no objections

Other modules are not used by sufficient enough number of sites to be considered centrally managed at this point



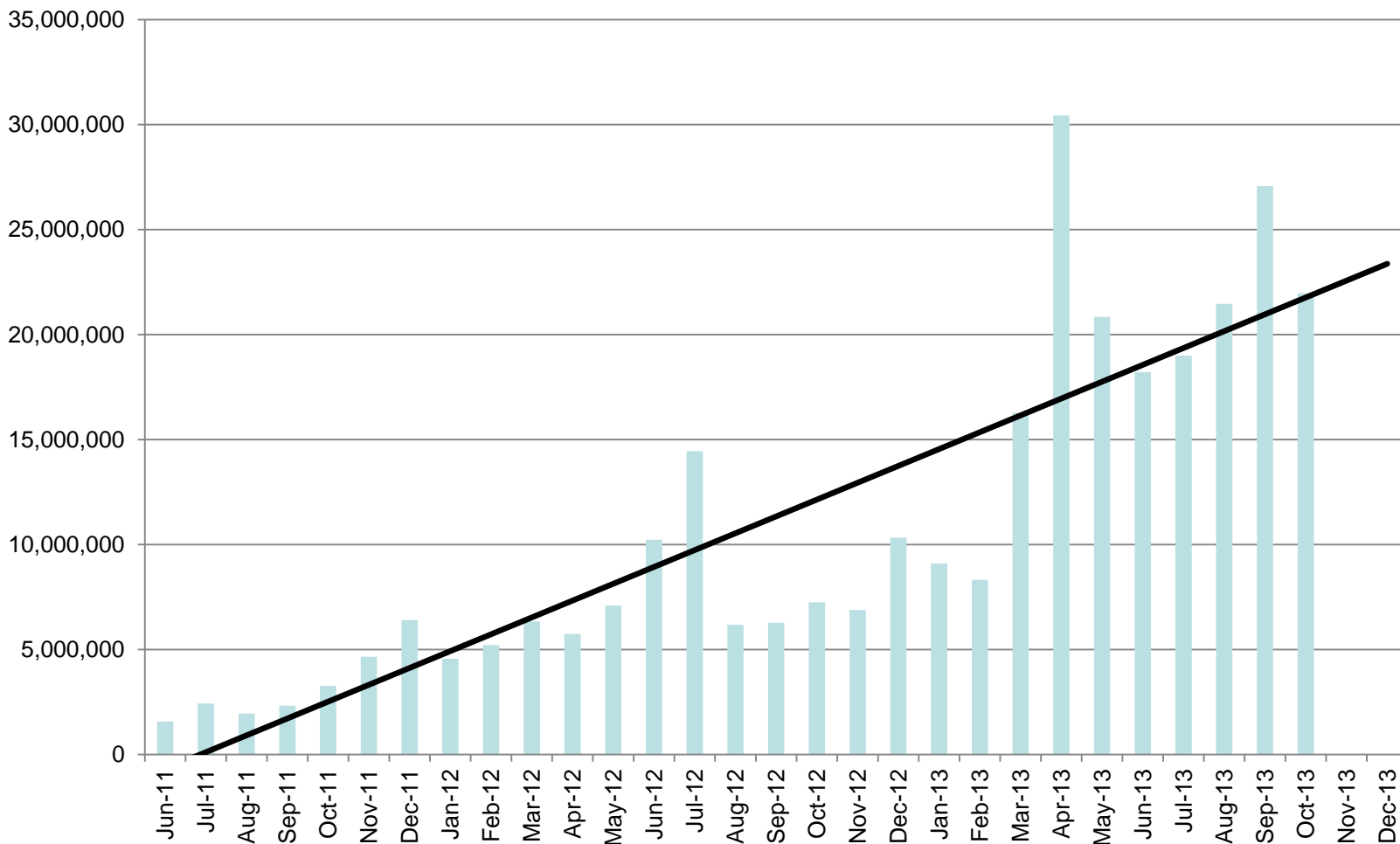
- Drupal 8: still many critical bugs and tasks:

- Current release: 8.0-alpha4 (Oct/2013)

Phase	Start date	End date
<u>Development phase</u>	March 10, 2011	December 1, 2012
<u>Feature completion phase</u>	December 1, 2012	February 18, 2013
<u>Clean-up phase</u>	February 18, 2013	July 1, 2013
<u>API completion phase</u>	July 1, 2013	TBD

- Alpha releases ← current step
 - Unstable and unreliable
 - APIs will still change
 - Only useful for module developers
- Beta releases (Q1/2 2014?)
 - No known critical bugs in upgrade path from 7.x to 8.x
 - APIs will still change
 - Module developers should start porting their modules
 - Site developers can start testing the new features and APIs
- Release candidates (Q3/4 2014?)
 - Major bugs resolved
 - APIs, user interfaces, and translatable strings should not change at this point
 - Suitable for early adopters to test on development sites
