- The exact text of the H2020 calls are still not known (Dec. 2013). Lets assume that there will be:
 - ✓ Two main periods for application 2014 and 2015
 - ✓ Equivalent call for “research infrastructures” in which AIDA was approved
 - ✓ Equivalent call for “training network” as present ITNs: *PhDs and postdocs*
 - ✓ Others to investigate and explore
- Continuation of AIDA (to be presented 2014):
 - ✓ Purpose: *Detector R&D*
 - ✓ Identify ILC common topics. Detector concepts and R&D collaborations.
 - ✓ AIDA 2 will have a meeting in February. ILC community is expected to present its views (L. Serin)

- New “ITN” (to be presented 2014):
 - ✓ Purpose:
 - *train PhD and postdocs,*
 - *performance and benchmark studies*
 - *develop computing for ILC across EU*
 - *cooperate with theory community*
- Other possibilities involving “larger funds” to be explored for the 2015 when possibly progress on the Japanese initiative become known
- Agenda of meetings and actions:
 - ✓ Next meeting before/after AIDA meeting ?? (once the official text of H2020 will be known) to find a:
 - *common approach to present/participate in the AIDA 2*
 - *start the configuration of a new “ITN” if the possibility exists*
 - *flrst thinkings to prepare a 2015 ILC call*
