## □ Progress since the last workshop:

- + Target `tplconvert` extended with a second pass conversion for old quattor-1.0's templates
- + Added new targets:
  - `markobsolete`:
    - prevents building of RPM
  - `tagstable`: adds a 'moving' CVS tag
    - `make revision|{minor,major}version` prompts for making STABLE;
- + Build framework's documentation (please review):
  - <https://twiki.cern.ch/twiki/bin/view/ELFms/QuattorBuild>

- Version *1.4-1*, possible release date *2008-05-01*
- Skip UNMANTAINED components?
  - + Unless really useful and known to work fine
- Skip OBSOLETE components
- Check STABLE tags before releasing:
  - + Only STABLE (possibly non-HEAD) tags will be released

- Quattor and CERN. People left, so:
  - + Manpower is needed
    - Any offer around?
    - Should we advertise?
  - + Some core modules need (possibly) maintainers: `cdp-listend`, `ncm-*`, `rpmt-py`, `spma`, `swrep-soap`, `wassh`
- Policy for admitting new developers?
  - + Assign a “tutor”?
  - + When to allow CVS writing?
- Code repository
  - + Should we move it elsewhere?
    - Again, CERN's strategy?
  - + Core developers should have admin rights
  - + Nightly builds from ETICS: what's the current experience?
