Adjustments to MOM Role & Responsibilities

- Discussions have started between operations manager and past MOMs
 - Reminder that MOM is meant to be a physicist role
 - More focus on running and preparations for running, than writing down numbers in boxes.
 - They WILL always remain the out of hours contact for MICE,
 WILL have the MOM phone and WILL check the MOM email.
- This is still in flux, and will be presented by Steve Boyd at CM38.
 - Past MOMs have been polled, but Steve would probably welcome comments from any collaborators.

Daily MOM Walkabout

- Daily walkabout has changed:
 - Still checking each area (Hall, MLCR, R9, R78) for problems.
 - Not writing down anything monitored by EPICS.
 - Happy to add elements for monitoring, but:
 - either short term only, or
 - Must be discussed with C&M group to instigate a proper monitoring scheme.
 - Ideally, the MOM shouldn't be writing down a number each day for more than a month.

General Reminder about MOMs

- We are only in the job temporarily, and the job currently has no formal training.
 - If you have a task for the MOM, consider:
 - Am I better qualified to do this task, would it be better to ask permission instead?
 - Am I completely explaining the task? If there is relevant documentation, mention it to the MOM.
 - Am I assuming that the MOM knows something already?
