

When you first arrive at CEA Saclay, you will need an access badge or "ID card". To get a badge, you must enter through the North Gate (*Porte Nord*) of the center, which is located on road D36, *Route de Chateaufort*.

Coming from Paris, Porte de Saint-Cloud by car

Follow the direction BORDEAUX. Cross the PONT DE SEVRES bridge and take N118 towards BORDEAUX. Exit onto SACLAY. From the Christ de Saclay roundabout, follow the map.

Coming from Paris by RER and bus

To CEA Saclay main gate (North Gate, also called "Porte Nord") (compulsory if you do not have an access badge) Take RER B towards "SAINT-REMY-LES-CHEVREUSE". Get off at "MASSY-PALAISEAU". Then take bus ALBATRANS 91-06 to the "CEA Porte Nord" bus stop.

Coming from Orly airport by RER and bus

The airport is located approximately 10 miles South of Paris. Take the "Orly Val" shuttle to the "ANTONY" bus station. Take RER B towards "SAINT-REMY-LES-CHEVREUSE". Get off at "MASSY-PALAISEAU". Then take the bus Albatrans 91-06 to the "Porte Nord" bus stop.

<u>Coming from Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport by RER and</u> <u>Bus</u>

The airport is located about 20 miles North of Paris. RER B is a train which runs from the Charles de Gaulle airport to the center of Paris. Take RER B towards "SAINT-REMY-LES-CHEVREUSE". Get off at "MASSY-PALAISEAU". Then take the bus Albatrans 91-06 to the "Porte Nord" bus stop.
