What is it?

- Lemon-host-check is:
 - The latest Lemon tool.
 - A tool for checking the current status of all configured exceptions on the machine.
 - A tool for managing the state of exceptions, with the ability to turn a exceptions off and on, on the fly without the need for reconfiguration of the agent.
 - The first command you should run whenever you believe monitoring is incorrect!!!
 - Works by instructing the local agent to refresh all metrics contributing towards exceptions (raw metrics) and then requesting a refresh of all exceptions.
 - Uses fresh monitoring data.
