SUBMISSION / CALL FOR ABSTRACTS:

Deadline: November 17, 2006.

Abstracts of contributions should be submitted to the Organising Committee. Please follow the instructions given in **http://vci.oeaw.ac.at** (click Submissions – Abstract).

Method of submission: please send LAT_EX files by e-mail to $\underline{vci@hephy.oeaw.ac.at}$ with the subject field submit-to-vci. (People who have no possibility to use LAT_EX can exceptionally submit their abstract as plain text.)

Please, don't forget to include name and e-mail address of the speaker and of the corresponding author (if different from the speaker).

The abstract should consist of no more than 20 lines (including header and empty lines). In addition, except for the invited talks, it must be accompanied by one *full size page* of more detailed information in order to allow the selection committee to make a sound decision. It should put the emphasis on new developments or at least reflect the progress achieved since the last Conference (2004). Please keep in mind that the presentation time for short talks is 20 minutes (discussion not included). For invited talks only the abstract is needed.

Receipt of all contributions will be acknowledged. The selection will be made by the International Scientific Advisory Committee together with the Organising Committee and will be completed by the middle of January 2007. No confirmation can be given before that date.

ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATIONS

ORAL PRESENTATIONS:

The speaker must be an author of the presented paper, and each person may give no more than one talk. The conference language is English. The talks must be presented on a computer video projector (beamer).

Any contribution for the beamer must be either a **Microsoft PowerPoint** (ppt) or an **Adobe Acrobat** (pdf) file. We encourage its early submission before the Conference – please, follow our instructions given in http://vci.oeaw.ac.at (click Submissions - Slides). In additional, you have to bring the beamer file **also on a CD-ROM, USB stick or diskette.** Support will be given to check the beamer file before the session. We are sorry that no private laptop connection to the beamer will be allowed.

Please make sure that your text and labelling of graphs is large enough to be readable. Be aware that some colours (e.g. bright green), which look good on the computer monitor may be almost illegible when projected from a beamer.

POSTER PRESENTATIONS:

The maximum width for a poster is 95 cm. A standard height of 119 cm is suggested. Otherwise we suggest using A0 format (84 x 119 cm 2) or 4 x 4 US Letter format (34" x 44"). At least one author of the poster must participate in the Conference and must be present at the poster session.

PROCEEDINGS

Elsevier/North-Holland Publishing Company will publish the proceedings of the Vienna Conference on Instrumentation as a special (but consecutively numbered) issue of **Nuclear Instruments & Methods in Physics Research**, **Section A**.

The deadline for submission of the paper is the last day of the conference.

Papers for both contributed oral presentations and for posters may by no means consist of more than 4 printed pages in the format of the journal NIM A, figures included (10 pages for invited talks). We ask you to kindly adhere to this strict limit. The final selection of papers for publication in NIM A will be made by the International Advisory Committee based on the quality of the contribution. In addition, an extended selection of papers will be made available on line on the Conference web site. *Please note that the manuscripts will not be accepted in case they have been published or are expected to be published elsewhere.*

The paper should be written in LAT_EX (vers. 2ϵ). For layout, figure captions and bibliography, please, follow carefully the **instructions** given on our web page **http://vci.oeaw.ac.at** (click Submissions – Paper). There you also find information for early submission before the conference. The LAT_EX source files and any additional files (e.g. graphics) must also be delivered to the **"submission desk" on a CD-ROM, USB stick or diskette** formatted for Windows or MacOS. In addition, we need 2 printed copies.

Tram (D) to "Oper", or from "Südtirolerplatz" (at walking distance) U1 to "Karlsplatz"

Tram (D) to "Oper"

Wien-Nord / Praterstern (railway station North):

Underground U1 to "Karlsplatz"

HOW TO REACH THE VENUE FROM THE AIRPORT:

Vienna International Airport (Wien-Schwechat):

The airport is situated approximately 20 km east of the centre of Vienna.

- "City Air Terminal (CAT) express train" to terminal station Wien-Mitte / Landstrasse, departure from the airport: every half hour (single ticket € 8.-). Then take the underground U4 to "Karlsplatz" (Tram Ticket € 1,50).
- ➤ Taxi from the airport to the centre of Vienna (about € 35.–).

The indicated fares are based on 2006 prices. For train/bus schedules and fares, please, consult the conference web page http://vci.oeaw.ac.at. There you can also find maps of the railway stations and their connection to the local public transport in Vienna.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT – basic information:

Vienna offers an efficient and modern system of public transport (called VOR), including underground (U), metropolitan train (S), trams and buses. There are also special night buses (N), which may be used with the standard tickets. The Conference venue is situated in the heart of historical Vienna and has easy access to the underground system (U1, U2, U4); almost all hotels are linked to the public transportation system. For details see the Conference web page http://vci.oeaw.ac.at/.

The **single ticket** can be used for any single trip in Vienna; you may change lines but without interruptions and without return; it costs € **1.50** when bought in advance (also sold as multiticket card of 4 or 8 stripes). Other tickets of interest:

- **8-day ticket**: 8 stripes, each valid for 1 person on 1 day (ending at 1:00 a.m.); days not necessarily consecutive, card may be shared; € **24.00**.
- Vienna Shoping Card € 4.00 (valid Mo Sa 8.00 20.00); 24 hour card: € 5.00.
- **Weekly pass**: valid Mo 0:00 a.m. Mo 9:00 a.m.; transferable; € 12.50.
- ➤ The **Vienna Card** is valid for 72 hours; in addition you obtain reductions of 11 50 % at nearly all museums, Schönbrunn and Belvedere Castle, exhibitions, concerts, theatres and other events; it costs **€ 16.90**.

Tickets must be stamped at the "blue box" located inside the tram or bus; for underground and metropolitan train it is located at the barrier before accessing the platform. Multi-ticket stripes must be used bottom-up, **starting with stripe #1**. Fares indicated as of 2006. For information about where you can buy tickets in advance see section "additional remarks" below.

ADDITIONAL REMARKS

You can purchase **public transportation tickets** at most tobacconists ("Tabak-Trafik"), VOR ticket offices, ticket distributor machines at underground stations (the next one is at "Karlsplatz" near exit Wiedner Hauptstrasse / Resselpark) and in some hotels; single tickets only (priced € 2.–) on the tram (machine in the 1st coach) and on the bus (from the driver).

The "Tabak-Trafik" in the conference venue (separate entry from the street) has special opening hours (Mon – Fri 6:00 – 18:00; Sat 7:30 – 12:00).

The **closest station** to the Conference venue is "Karlsplatz/Oper" with underground lines U1, U2, U4, bus lines 4A, 59A, tram lines D, J, 1, 2, 62, 65 and WLB (local tram to Baden); outward bound stop of tram lines 62, 65 and WLB in front of the Conference venue.

MONEY CHANGE:

We recommend using a bank (small change offices usually charge higher fees). The closest bank is **Bank-Austria-Creditanstalt**, Wiedner Hauptstrasse 11, A-1040 Wien (across the street in front of the Conference venue). Opening hours are Mon – Fri 8:00 – 12:30 and 13:30 – 15:00 (on Thu until 17:00). On Saturday and Sunday money change offices are open at the airport, at the Südbahnhof and Westbahnhof railway stations, and in Kärntnerstrasse.

Cash distributor machines (ATMs) are located next to most banks (watch for a green-blue, very broad "B" sign), either directly in the street, or inside the lobby (accessible with your card). Cards generally accepted are Maestro, Euro/MasterCard, DinersClub and Visa.

COPY SHOP:

There is a copy shop on the ground floor of the Conference venue (opening hours Mon – Thu 8:00 – 18:00, Fri 8:00 – 16:00). Another copy shop with longer opening hours is across the street from the Conference venue.

SHOPPING:

Shops are generally open Mon – Fri 9:00 - 18:00 and Sat 9:00 - 13:00. Many larger shops and shopping centres are open until 19:00 (on Sat until 17:00). Shops remain closed on Sundays (with a few exceptions, notably at the airport and at big petrol stations).
