#### **Status of Information Providers**

- Started to collect information about Information Providers on January 2013
  - https://twiki.cern.ch/twiki/bin/rdiff/EGEE/ISproviders
    - Maintainers and support
    - Code base
- Started to follow up also on open GGUS tickets reporting problems with Storage information
- On March 2013, started to check GLUE 2 publication

  - dCache: None (Because GLUE expert is part of the team)
  - Castor/EOS: GLUE 2 information provider missing

#### **GLUE 2.0 harmonisation**

- Review open issues tracked by Maria in https://twiki.cern.ch/twiki/bin/view/EGEE/GLUE2Storage
  - Make sure all Storage Systems publish things in the same way: protocol names, capabilities, etc
- Review Storage Capacities
  - Agree on the usage of capacity attributes
    - Discussion started last summer show developers do not always interpret attributes in the same way!
  - Think of a way to demonstrate the validity of storage capacities so VOs can rely on these numbers
    - In some cases there are easy ways to validate this:

#### **GLUE WG decisions**

- Recent GLUE WG meetings need input from Storage experts
  - Paul Millar is part of the WG, is this enough?
    - Could he be the link between Storage Developers and GLUE WG?
  - Need to extend Service Types and Interface Names
    - New Service Types: DPM
    - New Interface Names: webdav and xrootd



# Webdav/xroot endpoints

- VOs like ATLAS are interested in having webdav/xroot endpoints published in the BDII
  - DPM has fixed info provider to publish them (version 1.8.8 to be released soon)
  - StoRM does not seem to offer these access protocols (?)
    - But some sites like UKI-LT2-QMUL run an xroot server in parallel, how can this be published in the IS?
  - dCache seems to publish these endpoints
  - EOS?



#### **HTTP** federation

- Fabrizio Furano is interested in using the Information System to publish
  - Site prefixes
  - SRM prefixes
  - To be collected by the UGR (Uniform Generic Redirector)

### **Data Transfers Monitoring**

- Current WLCG Transfer Monitor covers data traffic perfored with
  - FTS
  - Xrootd federations
- FTS and xrootd servers were instrumented to report such transfers
- We ned to enable monitoring also for the HTTP/webdav data movement
  - It seems existing instrumentation does not work in this case
- Agreement and coordinated effort is needed among all storage providers
