## The sa1 requirements (to be raised at TCG) collection process in EGEEII:

- •ROC Managers were the main source of requirements:
  - -Each ROC proposed 5 m/w issues after internal discussion
  - Each ROC voted the issues considered most important
  - -The result was a prioritized table to be presented and periodically discussed at TCG

    - •Slow solution process, but some results have been achieved (i.e. logging document, error messages in SA3 checklist, documentation improvements)
  - -ISSUE: there was little discussion at the RM level after the first prioritization round no more requirements collected by ROCs



#### Requirements collection process -

**Enabling Grids for E-sciencE** 

- Direct site managers contact asking feedback on m/w quality:
  - Done using mail survey through the broadcast tool
    - Stockholm workshop, Sam review, Budapest conference
  - Little participation (about 15/20 feedbacks per survey) but valuable material received anyway
  - Positive experience

How we want to proceed in EGEEIII...

The general guideline is to improve and strengthen the direct link with the site managers in search for further requirement sources

#### Few ideas:

- Constant participation to operation meetings
- Periodical Surveys similar to those done in few circumstances during EGEEII
- •A forum or a dashboard somewhere on the web to discuss directly with site managers hot topics maybe introduced by the surveys
- Unsolved ticket parsing

New m/w requirements should be much more specific with respect to those created in EGEEII in order to simplify their presentation and solution
