MEETUPS (1)

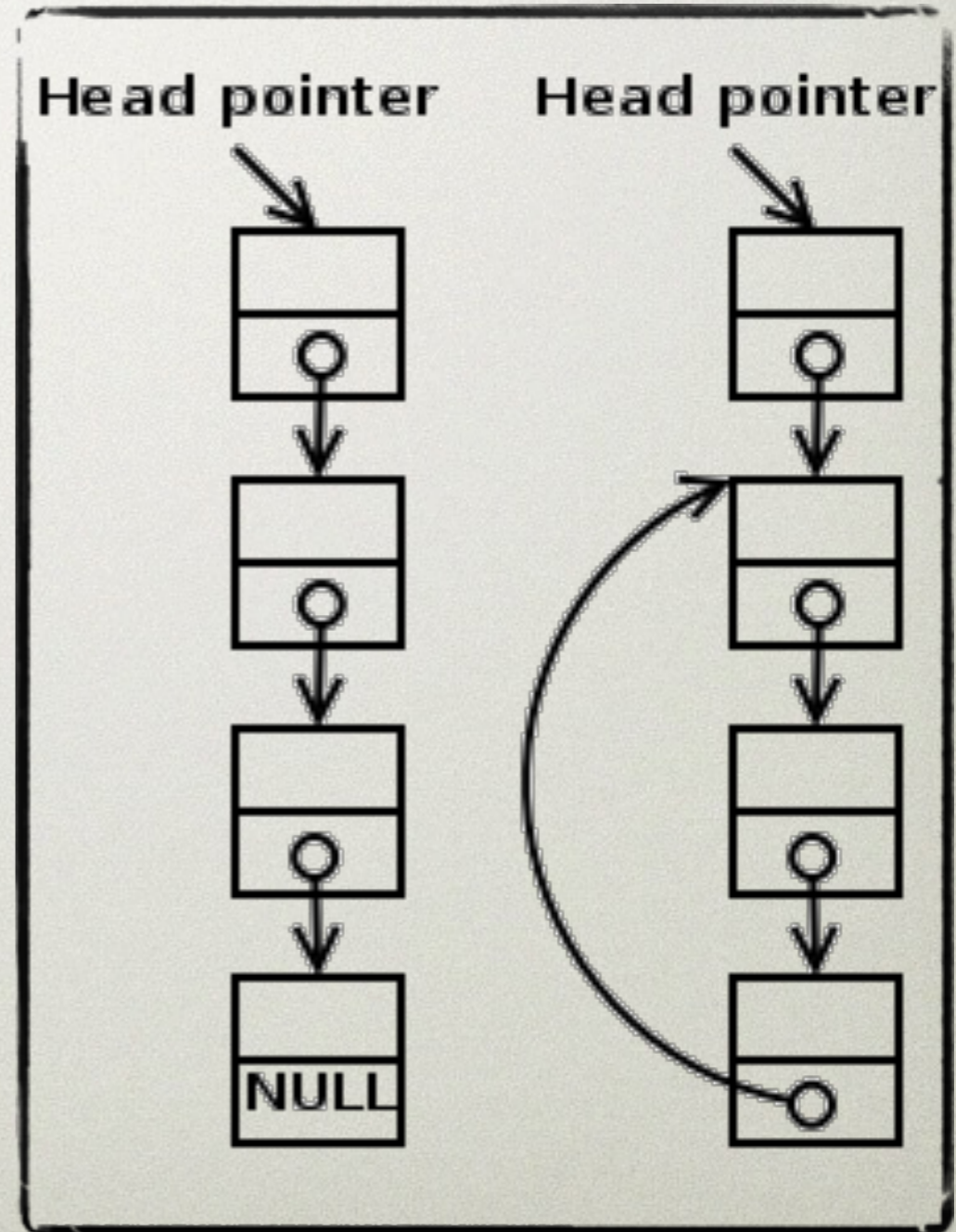
- Why meetups? Because...

ALGORITHMIC PUZZLE (TEASER)

- 2 types of linked lists
 1. null-terminated
 2. loopback
- input: head pointer
- output: type (1 or 2)
