Concept of Masterclasses

* Concept

- * Students (15 -19 years old) spend 1 day at research institute,
- * experience science from scientists "The Master" and
- * carry out measurements based on analyses of real data from particle physics experiments,
- * discuss their results with colleagues
- * basic idea from UK (1996, Roger Barlow et al.)


* Objectives

- * stimulate students interest in physics
- * demonstrate scientific research process
- * let students explore fundamental forces and building blocks of matter
- * offer authentic experience



Concept of Masterclasses

- **Event** create an International Collaboration among students (together with U.S. partner QuarkNet)
 - * ~4 weeks period in March every year
 - * 130 (+30 from U.S. partner) institutes from 37 countries
