

Middleware news

- New GFAL2 2.9.2 fixing FTS3 bringonline daemon crashes now installed in
 - RAL, CERN, BNL and FNAL
- Issue with Globus library (globus-gssapi-gsi-11.16-1) released in EPEL testing (GGUS:114076)
 - It changes the default behaviour in the way to check whether a host certificate is legitimate or not
 - This change is desirable for security reasons and was first requested 11 years ago! <u>https://bugzilla.mcs.anl.gov/globus/show_bug.cgi?id=1753</u>
 - It may affect any service behind an alias whose host certificate does not include the correct subject alternative names
 - Failure is seen on the client side when connecting to these services (Spotted for the FTS and MyProxy services at CERN)
 - We do not want to equip client hosts with a non default configuration
 - After discussion with developers, they have released a new version (globus-gssapi-gsi-11.18-1) which defaults to the previous behaviour
 - This is a temporary measure

LCG

- WLCG Operations will check on services that may fail with the new default behaviour
- Developers will eventually release the new default behaviour

Experiment reports

- High activity due to preparation of RUN 2
- And finally fairly smooth start of RUN 2 data taking for all LHC experiments!
 - Experiments running high number of production jobs mostly without problems
- ALICE
 - High activity with no major operational issues
- ATLAS
 - Rucio performance very good
 - HLT reprocessing of first week data run successfully
 - WNs particularly slow at Tier-0 due to a bug in Openstack (Internal CERN SNOW ticket INC0796407)
 - Troubles due to FTS Bringonline daemon down (GGUS:114021)
- CMS
 - DIGI-RECO campaign progressing very well
 - Global Xrootd re-director at CERN with higher impact and urgency defined in the WLCG critical services table (already updated)
 - EOS issues and bad transfer quality from T0 reported and fixed (several GGUS tickets)
- LHCb
 - First offline data workflow processing over the past weekend
 - Ongoing issue with access to SARA storage, could be related to fetch-crl issue discovered recently (GGUS:113766)
 - LHCb has asked to create "tape families" for the Run2 data to T1 sites

Task Forces

RFC Proxies

- Readiness of the WLCG infrastructure for RFC proxies will first be tested through the SAM preprod instance of each experiment
- The SAM proxy renewal sensor first needs an easy fix to support both RFC and legacy proxies
- HTTP Deployment
 - First steps agreed:
 - Identification of an appropriate monitoring solution
 - Full list of functionality that the experiments would like to see delivered via HTTP
 - Second meeting focused on requirements on storage
 - A summary will be presented at the next Ops Coord meeting



Working Groups

- Middleware Readiness
 - dCache v.2.10.28 now part of the baseline
 - StoRM verification for ATLAS at CNAF
 - MW Readiness App in production
 - https://wlcg-mw-readiness.cern.ch/
 - It will eventually replace the manually maintained baseline table

Network and Transfer Metrics WG

- LHCOPN and LHCONE meshes are stable now and consistently delivering metrics
- Planning to establish WLCG-wide meshes for all types of tests
- Network performance incident process is now in place with a new GGUS SU "WLCG Network Throughput" to report any issues

Information System

Information System

- OSG BDII unavailable for 14h (GGUS:114052)

- Cache showed OSG sites for 12h then OSG sites disappeared from sam-bdii but no side effects reported
- OSG is in the process of deprecating and removing the BDII in conjunction with USCMS and USATLAS stakeholders
 - First USCMS sites taken out
 - Ongoing effort within USATLAS where the BDII service will run for as long as a stakeholder needs it
 - OSG BDII will be provided as long as stakeholders have completely transitioned
 - A deprecation date has not been set, it will be determined in the near future

- It will centralize Ops information
