- National Grid Service (NGS)
 - UK's national infrastructure provider for all research areas
- Based at 4 core sites each with dedicated machines
 - Universities of Manchester, Leeds and Oxford
 - STFC Rutherford Appleton Laboratories (RAL)
 - Also 13 other partner and affiliate sites who contribute resources
