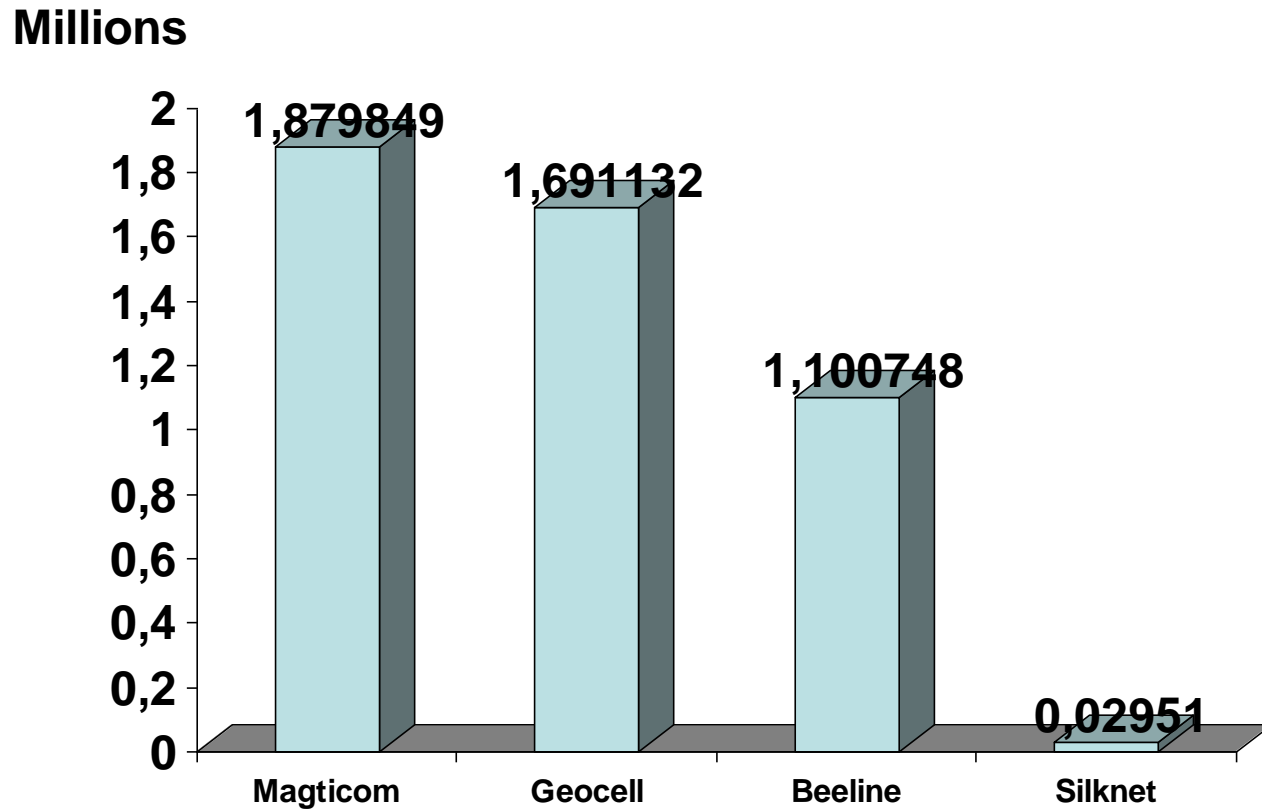
# Subscribers in Georgia

# Government Network

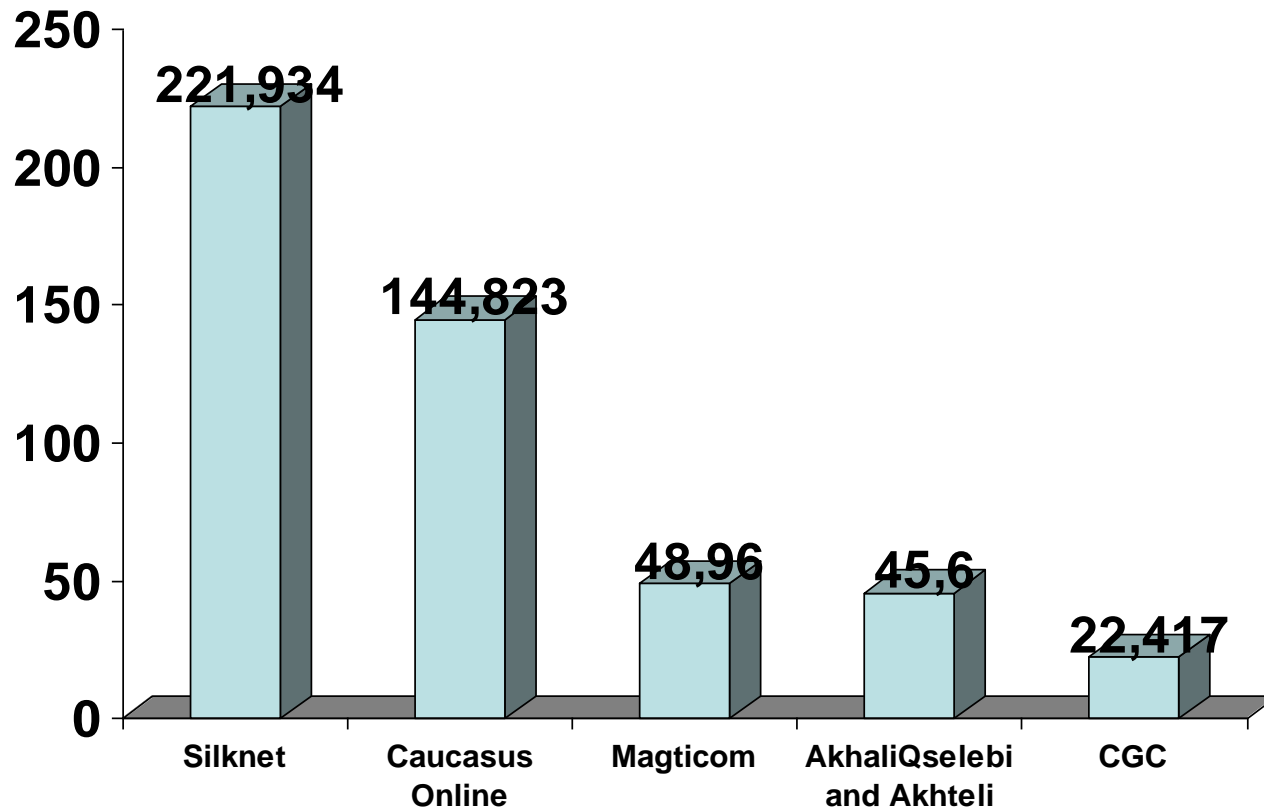
- In 2007 Georgian government announced a tender to build so called GGN (Georgian Governmental Network) across the whole Georgia.

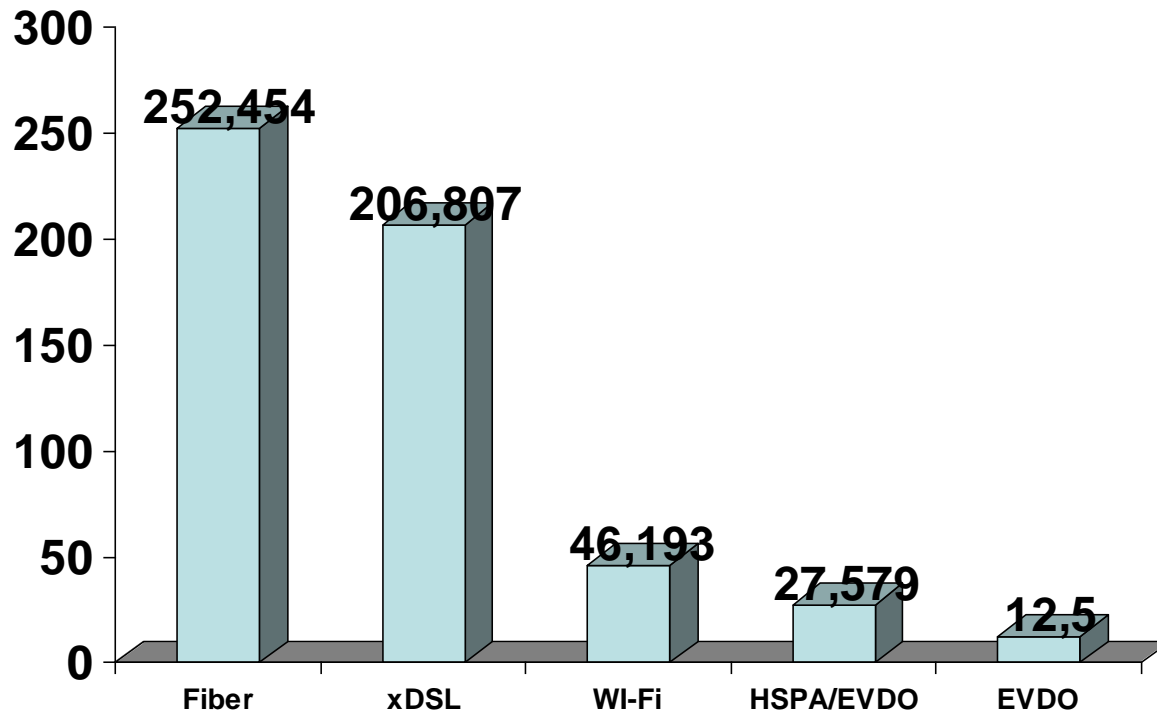

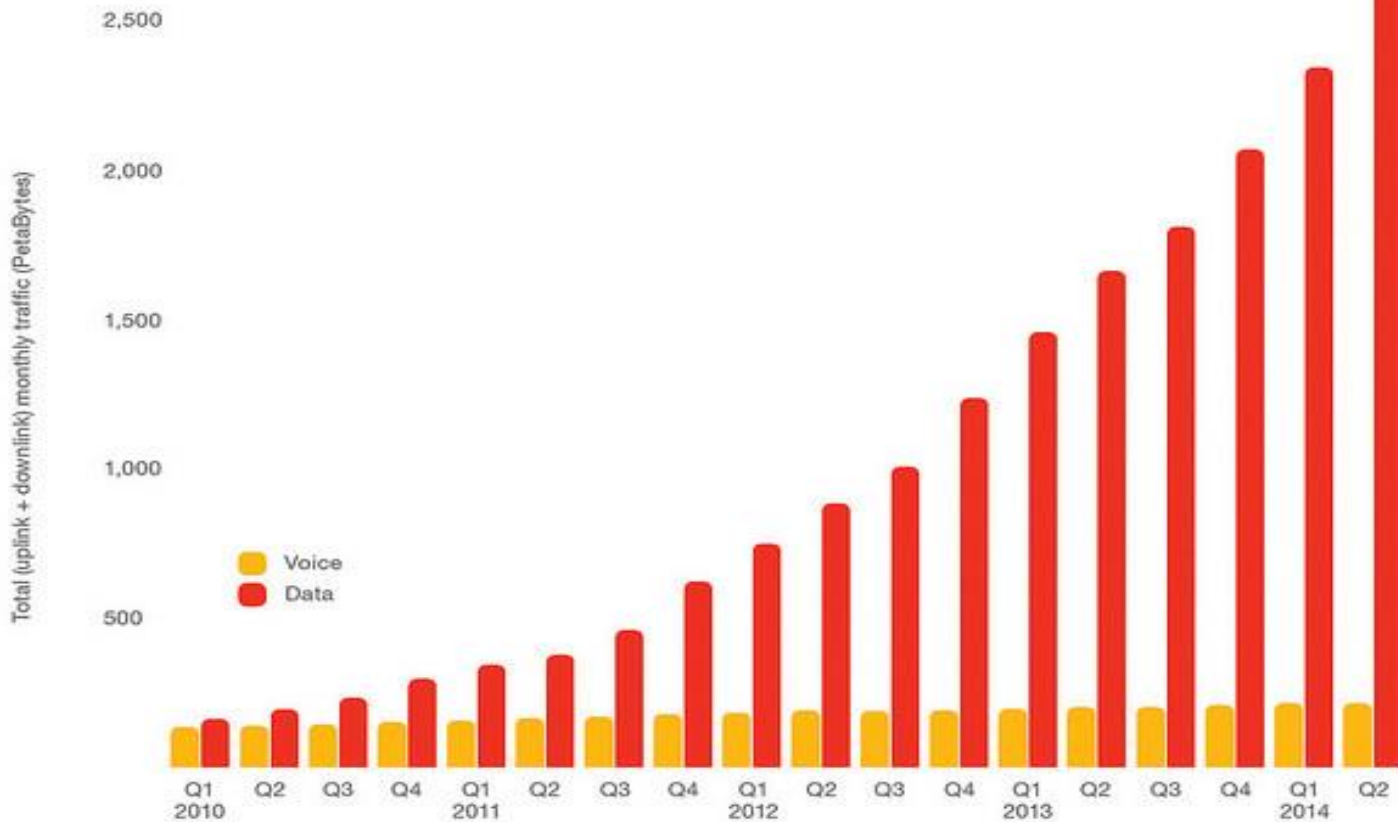


# Network technologies used in Georgia (number of subscribers)

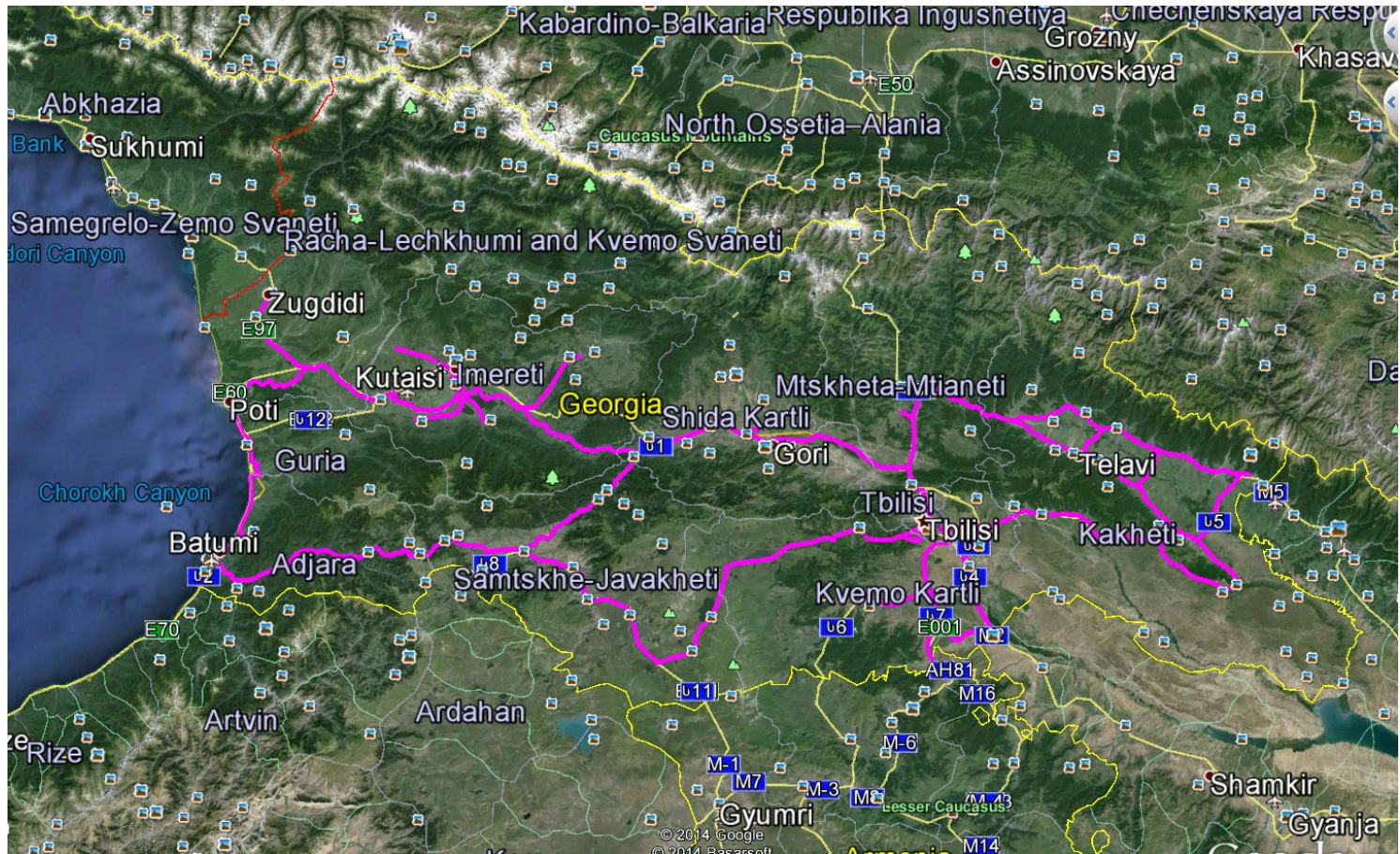

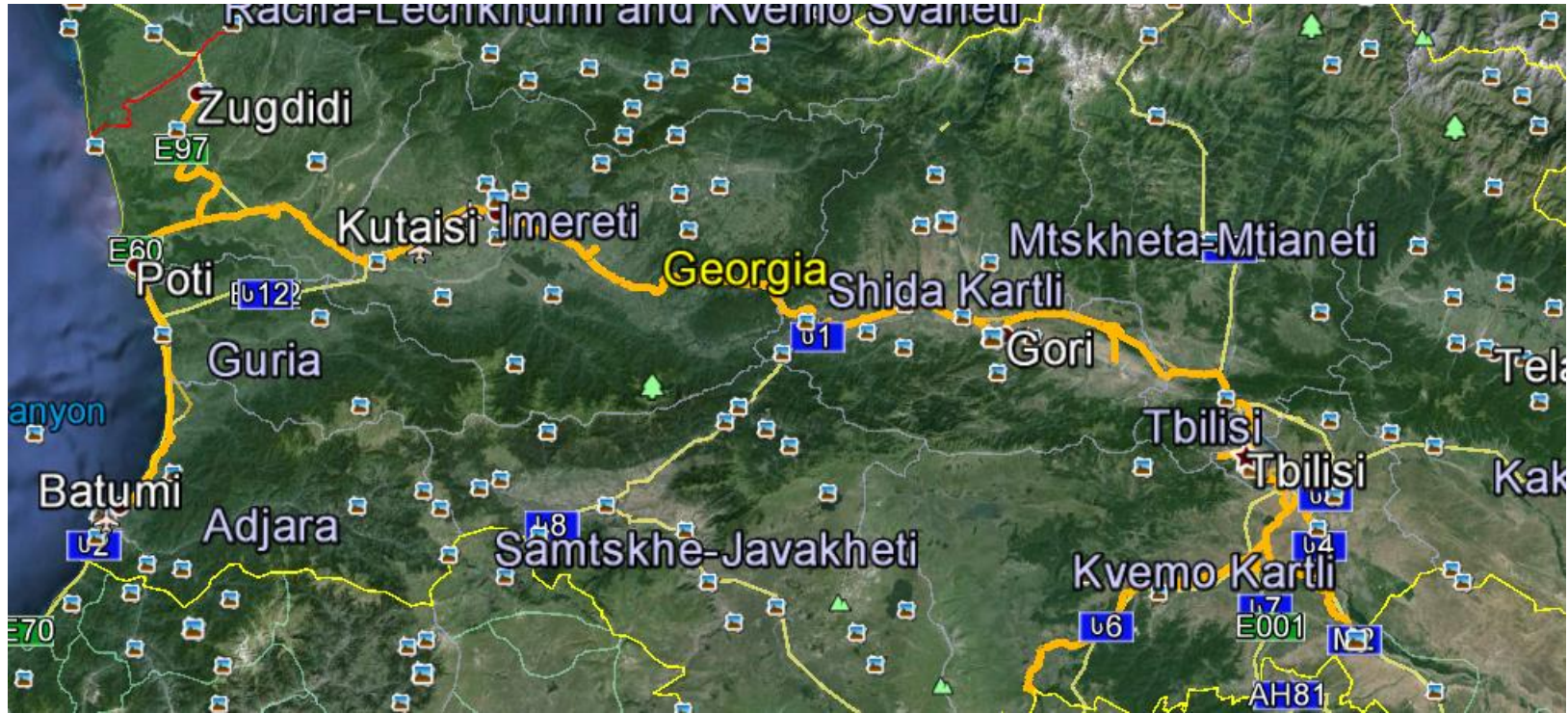
