The manuscripts of the Oral and Poster presentations should be submitted **at least one day before the talk at the latest** on a USB memory stick for uploading, or directly to the web page.

- Please bring your poster **PRINTED**. We will **NOT** provide assistance for printing the poster on site.
- Post the **POSTER** by the morning of 26th to the board with your contribution ID.

All contributions, orals and posters, are eligible for inclusion in the conference issue of **Nuclear Instruments and Methods, Section A**. The **paper** should be submitted by the **deadline of Nov.6 (tentative)** and conformed to the rules of Elsevier (<http://authors.elsevier.com/journal/nima>).

Xi’an Weather

September marks the pleasant autumn of Xi’an, In middle and late September, it is comfortable with large temperature difference between day (up to 25oC) and night time (low to 11oC). The wind is very gentle and comfortable. Xi’an remains in the rainy season with an average of over ten rainy days in September. A temperature drop always comes along with a rain. Average temperature (low/middle/high): 16/20/25 C, 61/68/77 F, average humidity: 79%.
