- Received a strange email this week?
- **Had a ~9% click rate!**
 - Just below academic average...
 - Come on HEPiX, you know better!
- This email was:
 - Sent with many suspicious fields
 - IP address: a dedicated “fake mail service” in eastern Europe IP
 - No LinkedIn headers or any link pointing to LinkedIn.com
 - Had non-LinkedIn URLs including the word “phishing” in the code
 - Pete has no LinkedIn account anyway...
- Some people “thought” this was not a real phishing
 - But user-agents suggest no evidence of that
 - Could have tried to exploit you anyway!
- *“If we can get the target to visit us in some sort of Web browser, we can probably own them. The only limitation is “how”.” —NSA report*
