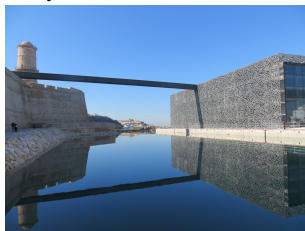


Agenda of the week (1)

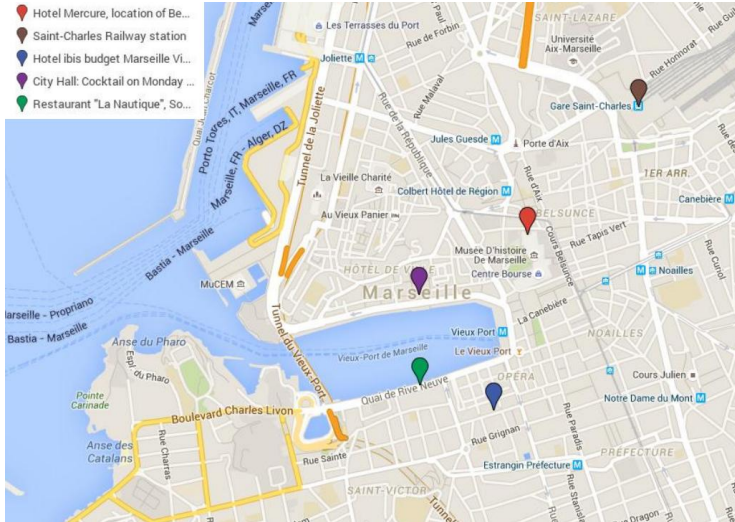
Agenda of the week (2)
