It is recommended to make hotel reservations as early as possible. At the time of the conference there is high demand for accommodation due to local events.

Thessaloniki is served by Macedonia Airport which is located 14 km away from the city center. The airport is served on a 24-hour basis by public transport. There are direct flights to major European cities and connecting flights with the Athens El. Venizelos airport. There are also some direct flights from the USA. Alternatively you can reach Thessaloniki travelling by boat from Italy (Ancona, Brindisi) to Igoumenitsa and then by car through the Egnatia highway. There are also connections by train to western and eastern European cities.

Conference participants are requested to familiarize themselves with visa requirements well in advance of the conference. EU Nationals do not need a visa to enter Greece, but a valid ID card or passport is required. Non-EU nationals in general require a visa for stays in Greece. A visa is not required for semi-annual visits of up to three months for nationals of those countries for which the European Community has abolished the visa requirement. Nationals of countries which do not have a visa-waiver agreement with the European Community must obtain a visa. Letters of invitation for visa purposes will be available upon request for registered conference participants.
