The aim of the conference is to review the status and progress of the quark confinement phenomena, hadron spectroscopy and related research. The program consists of plenary and parallel sessions. The list of parallel sessions is the following:

Poster session and oral presentations

The Poster session at this meeting has become an excellent venue for presenting ideas in an informal setting. It has become a tradition to have a wine tasting party associated with the poster session. Therefore, the conference participants are encouraged (but not obliged) to bring to the meeting a bottle of wine from their own country. People from non-wine producing countries are welcome to bring another traditional beverage.

The Poster session will take place in the evening of August 30th, from 19:30 onwards. A selection committee will judge the posters. Awards will be given to the three best posters. In addition, honorable mentions will be awarded for the best graphical design and for the best poster by a Senior physicist.

The criteria for the selection of the five "Best Poster Awards" are the following, in alphabetical order:

- Age and experience of candidate
- Clarity of figures and graphs and their description
- Graphical design and layout
- Originality of scientific content
- Quality of oral presentation and answers to questions during poster session
- Readability and clarity of poster contents
- Scientific value of offered results / conclusions of offered study

The winners of the selection will be announced in the evening of August 31st, after the excursion. Awards winners will receive an award certificate, a gift, and a letter of commendation signed by the conference organizers and by the poster selection committee members.

Winners of the awards and honorable mention and special mention recipients will be offered a chance to present the content of their poster in a 5' "Flash talk" during the plenary session of September 2nd.

Other information:

- Double-sided boards measuring 200 cm (height) x 95 cm (width), i.e., portrait format, will be available for each author to attach their posters to. The authors are advised not to use the full space of the board, but to limit their poster size to 120 cm (height) x 90 cm (width). Double-sided tape will be provided by the organizers.
- it is possible to print your poster on site, at the cost of 35 EUR Important! Interested participants must send their posters (PDF files) to NB Events agency (bai@nbevents.gr) by August 26th the latest Posters will be ready to pick up at the registration desk
- Displays created by stitching slides or article pages are strongly discouraged
- Posters should remain affixed for three days following the poster session

Preparing oral presentations and posters

PDF is the preferred format for your slides and posters. We will also accept PowerPoint format (until PowerPoint 2012) but we encourage you to use PDF unless at least some feature of PowerPoint is strictly necessary.

You will not be able to plug your computer to the projector.

The speakers should upload the slides to the indico server latest on the day before the session is held. In case of any problem, please contact Łukasz Graczykowski (lgraczyk@if.pw.edu.pl) or Vladimir Kovalenko (vladimir.kovalenko@cern.ch) and send them your presentation on the evening of the day preceding your talk the latest. As a last resort, the convener of the parallel session should receive the presentation via a USB key before the session. In case a presentation is not available on time (latest beginning of the lunch break before the parallel session), any time-loss caused because of this reason will be taken from the time allocated for the presentation. For plenary sessions please provide the USB key to Łukasz Graczykowski (lgraczyk@if.pw.edu.pl) or Vladimir Kovalenko (vladimir.kovalenko@cern.ch) well before the session starts.

Posters should also be uploaded to Indico system.

FROM MAKEDONIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

If you are reaching the Makedonia Palace Hotel from Makedonia International Airport (13 km)

By bus: Faliro bus stop of line 78 (Airport – Bus Station) is less than 150 m away from the hotel.

By car: You follow Georgikis Scholis Avenue towards west. At some point, its name changes to Ethnikis Antistaseos, Vas. Olgas Avenue and then Vas. Georgiou Avenue. In the lights of City Hall of Thessaloniki, the left turn will lead you to Meg. Alexandrou Ave, and after approx. 400 m you will find the hotel on your right.

By taxi: There is a taxi rank at the Airport (16-20 € from Makedonia International Airport to CONF12 Venue – Makedonia Palace Hotel)

FROM THE TRAIN STATION

If you are reaching the Makedonia Palace hotel from the Train Station (4 km)

By bus: Faliro bus stop of line 8 (New Train Station – IKEA East Terminal Station) is less than 150 m away from the hotel.

By car: You follow Monastiriou street towards east, and right after Dimokratias square you take a right to Dodekanisou street (Salaminos street at a later point) to reach the entrance of the Port's Passenger Terminal entrance. Then you take a left to Kountouriotou Street (Nikis Ave at a later point) until you reach the White Tower. Then you follow Meg. Alexandrou Ave, and after approx. 400 m you will find the hotel on your right.

By taxi: There is a taxi rank at the Train Station (8-10€ from Train Station to CONF12 Venue – Makedonia Palace Hotel)

FROM THESSALONIKI CITY CENTER

If you are reaching the Makedonia Palace hotel from the center of the city (3 km)

By bus: Faliro bus stop of line 8 (New Train Station – IKEA East Terminal Station) is less than 150 m away from the hotel.

Faliro bus stop of line 5 (Nea Krini – IKEA Venizelou) is less than 150 m away from the hotel.

Faliro bus stop of line 6 (Kalamaria – Venizelou) is less than 150 m away from the hotel.
