GENERAL REMARKS

- 2 caverns to be cleaned: UXC55 and USC55
- During LHC operation UXC55 is not accessible, thus no cleaning possible
- USC55 is a radiological non designated area (no dosimeter needed), also during LHC operation!

UXC55

• Today:

- a team of 2 persons 3 times a week in the morning
- This cleaning frequency is sufficient

USC55

 Cleaning of USC55 is done in with the same team of UXC55, but only during the remaining time after UXC55 is cleaned.

CMS CONTACT PERSON

 The CMS contact person for setting the day to day cleaning priorities in USC and UXC is Maf Alidra

FUTURE DEMANDS

- We need a a general cleaning campaign before LHC start-up and after every long shut down in UXC55
- We must reduce all dust in order not to produce contamination
- Especially on the detector!
- Estimated time 1 week

FUTURE DEMANDS

 During LHC operation the cleaning frequency can be reduced to 2 times/ week since only USC55 can be cleaned
