

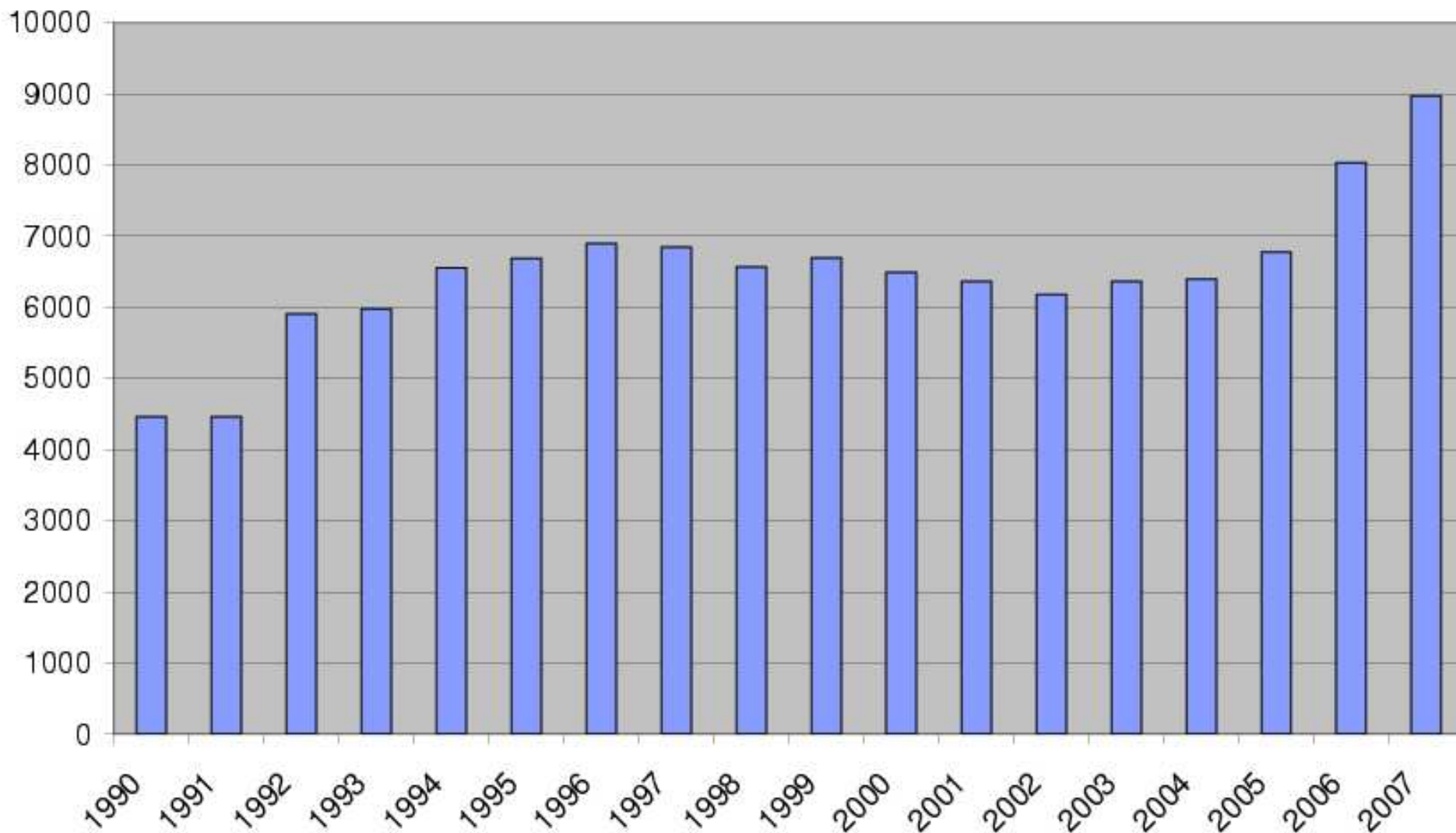

 \Rightarrow conclusions by Cigdem Issever

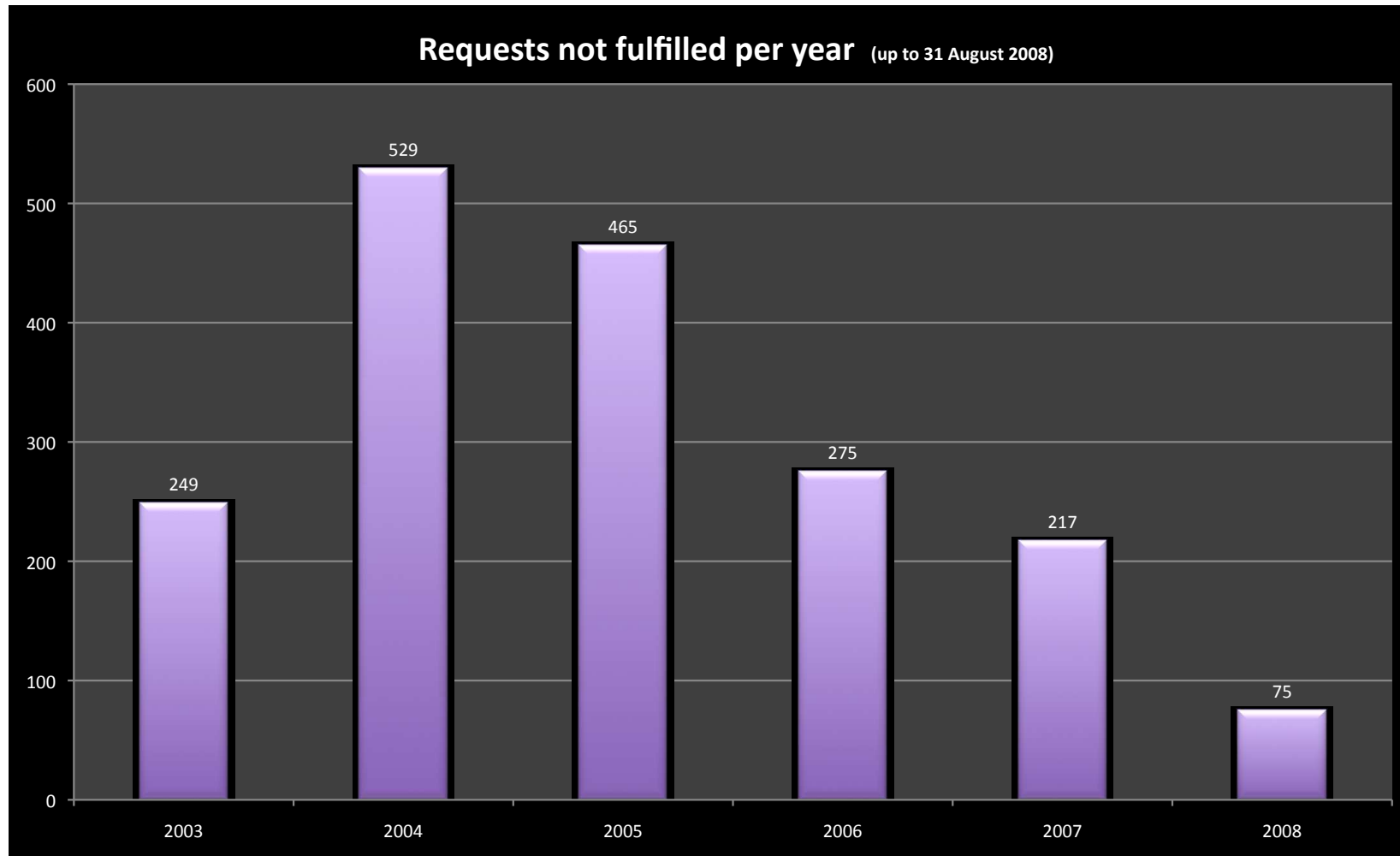
- ❑ Existing Child Care (CC) is **not sufficient**
- ❑ Existing CC is **too expensive for users**
- ❑ **Survey** shows only the **“tip of the iceberg”**
 - ❑ need re-do survey with help from CERN
 - ❑ e.g. CERN user office has a lot of information we can use
- ❑ Need help from CERN to **tap into ESF funds**
- ❑ **Child Care has to become a high priority issue for CERN**

- **Archamps** construction **great opportunity**
 - Try to get ESF funds for child care!
 - **CERN could provide affordable child care for users and staff!**
 - ESF = European Social Fund
 - **Immediate Actions:**
 - **CCCI and CERN management need to meet**
 - **Assign person from CERN legal office to follow-up ESF**
 - **Assign a person from the CERN management to be responsible for child care at CERN full time.**

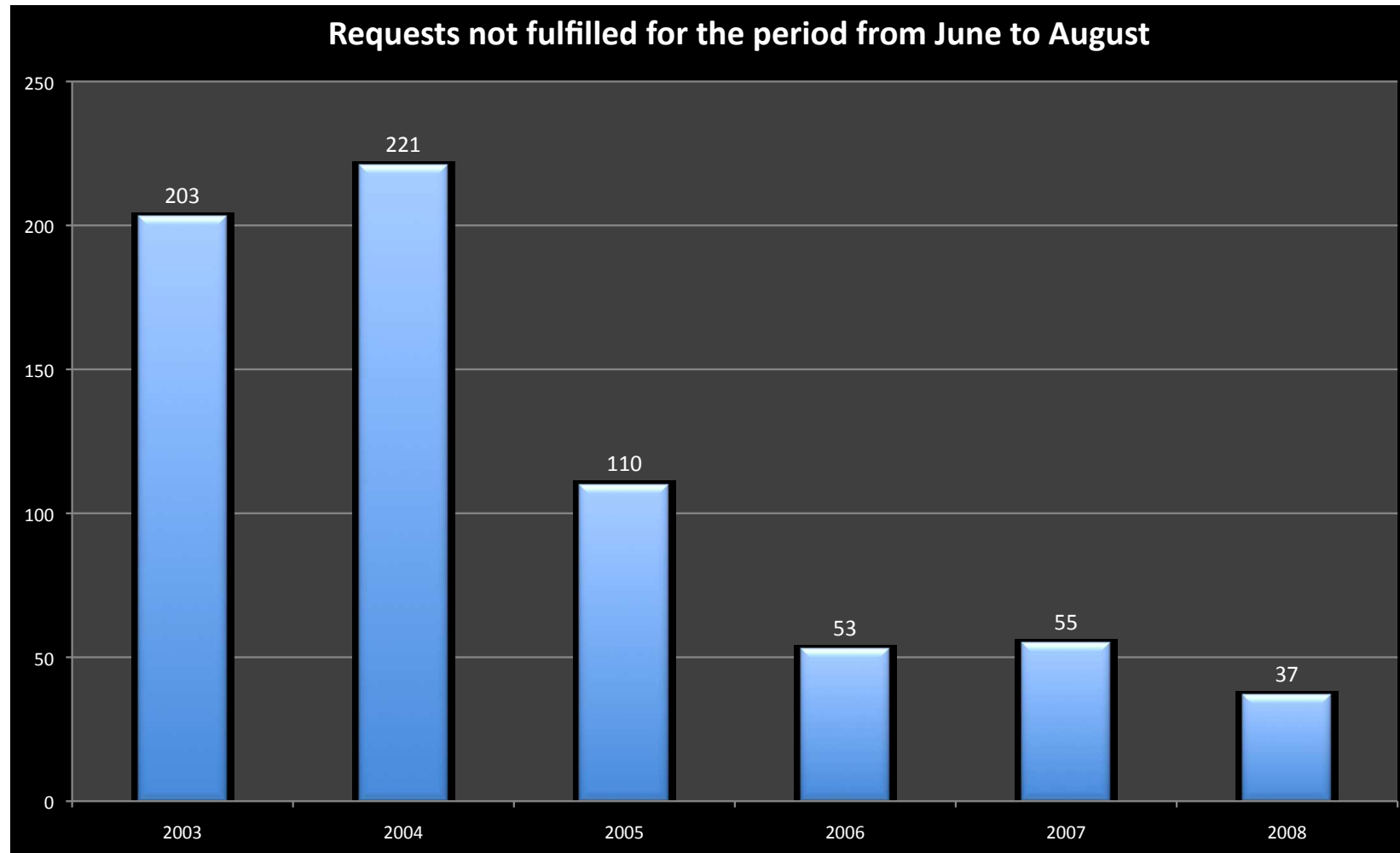
Inauguration of the tram Cornavin - Avanchet on the 8.12.2007

Nb. of non-honoured requests per year went down.



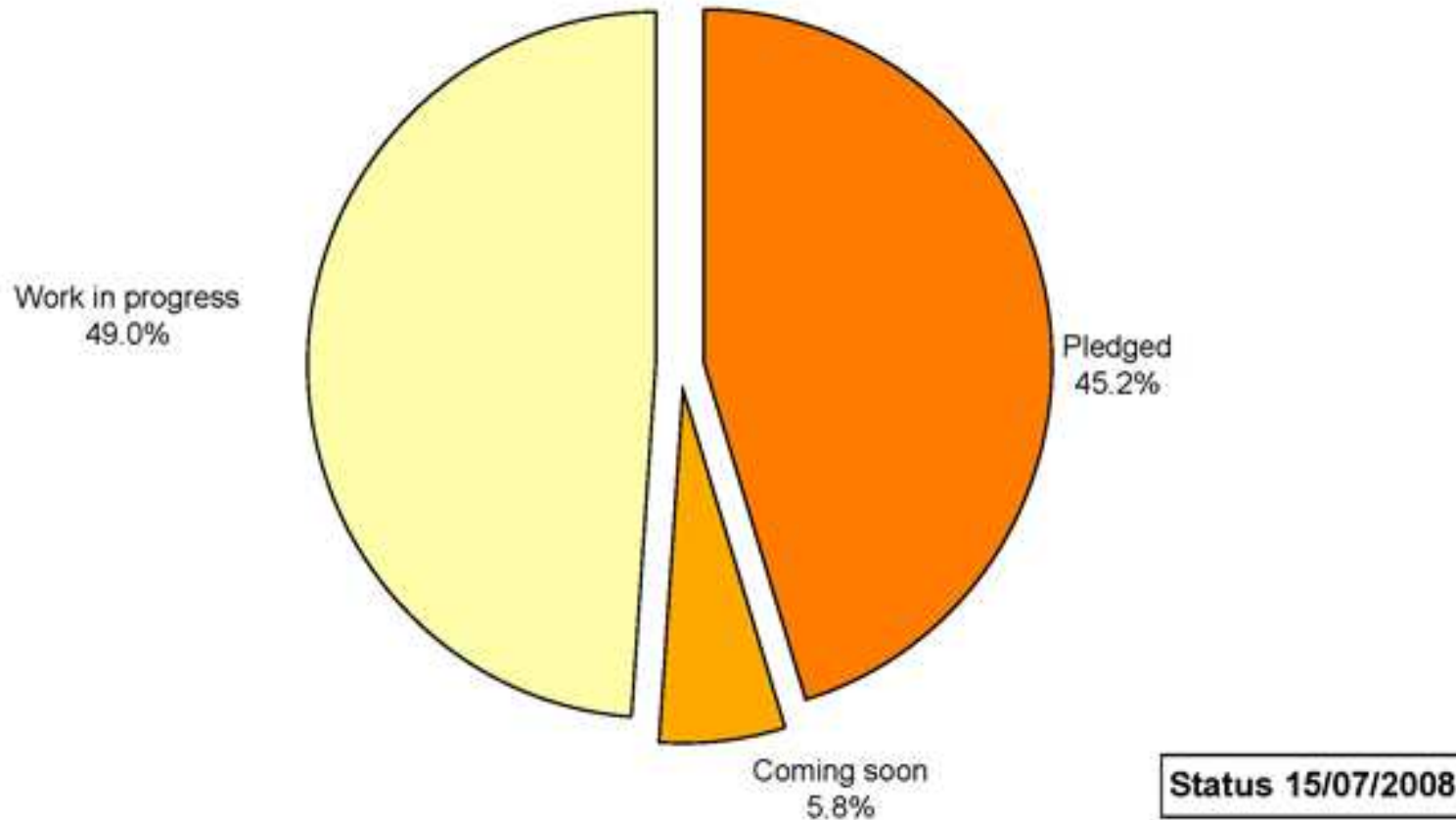
In preparation: Installation of electronic locks

Different recourse mechanisms at CERN. Only IT dep. has an ombudsperson.
