Grant Agreement

- The Grant Agreement is signed between the European Commission (EC) and CERN as the Coordinator, with all Project partners acceding to it as further Beneficiaries.
- The Partner Organisations are not Beneficiaries, they do not receive funding from the EC and are not parties to the Grant Agreement.

Consortium Agreement

- The Consortium Agreement is signed between CERN as the Coordinator and all Beneficiaries (consortium).
- The Partner Organisations are not parties to the Consortium Agreement.
- The Consortium Agreement is based on the DESCAL model consortium agreement, tailored to the E-JADE Project as regards the budget provision and the staff exchange provision.

Partnership Agreements

- All consortium partners requested to conclude agreements (“Partnership Agreements”) as regards the sending of own staff and the hosting of staff of a partner organisation
- All staff exchange arrangements must respect the provisions of the Consortium Agreement as regards IP, publication and confidentiality.
- CERN will provide PA template as an example of how CERN exchanges employed members of the personnel with other organisations.
