

Nuclear Physics European Collaboration Committee

B. Krusche, 83rd meeting, Basel, Switzerland, June 12/13 2015:

◆ Future NuPECC relations with ESF, ESF successor report by J.C. Worms (ESF)

- New Science Europe responsible only for Science Policy (no expert boards etc.)
- plans for ESF successor to host expert boards etc. positively evaluated; to be presented to governance (June) and assembly (November)
- 5 of 6 expert boards (including NuPECC) decided to stay with ESF successor
- Successor organization could start in Jan. 2016

◆ New NuPECC long range plan (last was 2010)

- Schedule (final version March 2017) and NuPECC responsables fixed
- Topics: Hadron Physics, Strong Interaction Matter, Nuclear Structure and Dynamics, Nuclear Astrophysics, Fundamental Interactions and Symmetries, Tools and Applications for Society
- **Important: Formation of working groups under way, in case of interest (e.g. Fundamental Interactions, Applications in Medicine) please contact B.K.**
