- UMD 3.12.0 released on May5
 - <http://repository.esi.eu/2015/05/05/release-umd-3-12-0/>
 - ARGUS-PAP, dCache server 2.10.24
- Next UMD major release planned at the end of May

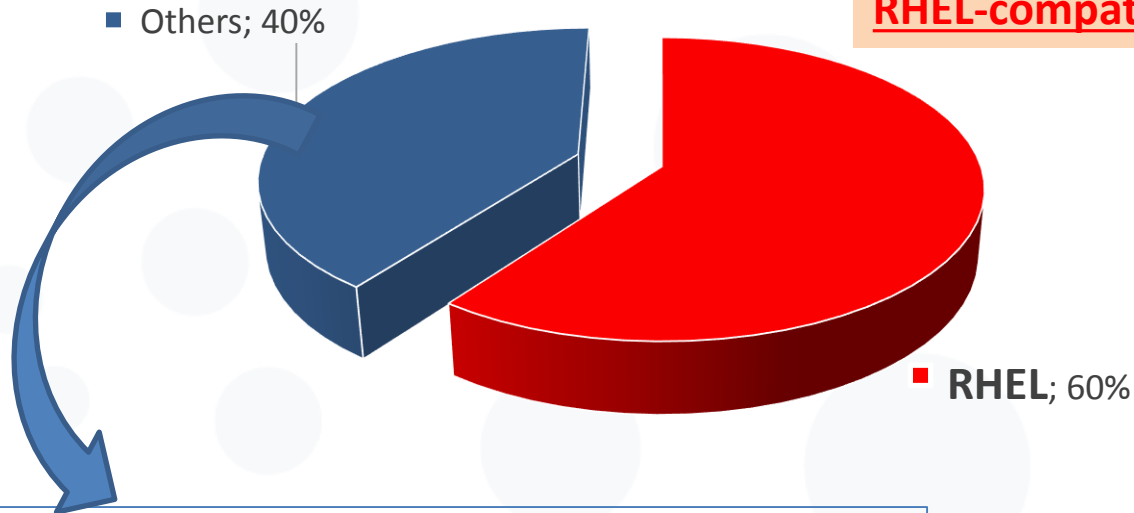
- SL5 support aligned with RHEL5
 - no more "Full support"
 - end of "Transition" Phase on January 31, 2014
 - not getting new software functionalities anymore
 - in "Maintenance" until March 31, 2017
 - only urgent/critical fixes until then
- Quick search in top BDII
 - more than 500 entries publishing RHEL6-compat
 - about 100 entries publishing RHEL5-compat
- Result: **more than 80% not using RHEL5-compat Oses**
- Supporting CentOS7 in UMD requires to schedule the end of support of SL5 in UMD

- Providers feedback at last URT meetings
 - 13 products are ready for EPEL7
- Several providers asking for explicit statement to develop for EPEL7
- Especially CREAM not supported but warmly asked in CentOS7

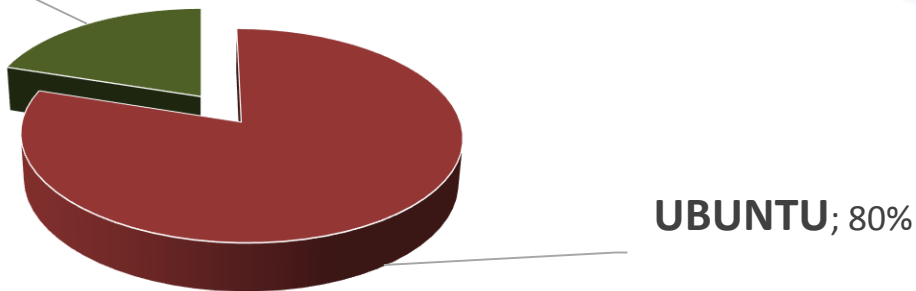
- Still some sites on SL5, generally going to migrate during the next months
- Some sites might stay longer with SL5 for some applications
- Issue with few applications still on SL5, support for SL6 is work-in-progress
- Some sites are already using SL7 and cannot deploy MW
- Already assessing internally the need of having UMD products in CentOS7/SL7

FedCloud in EGI

60% of cloud sites base their cloud infrastructure on RHEL-compat distributions

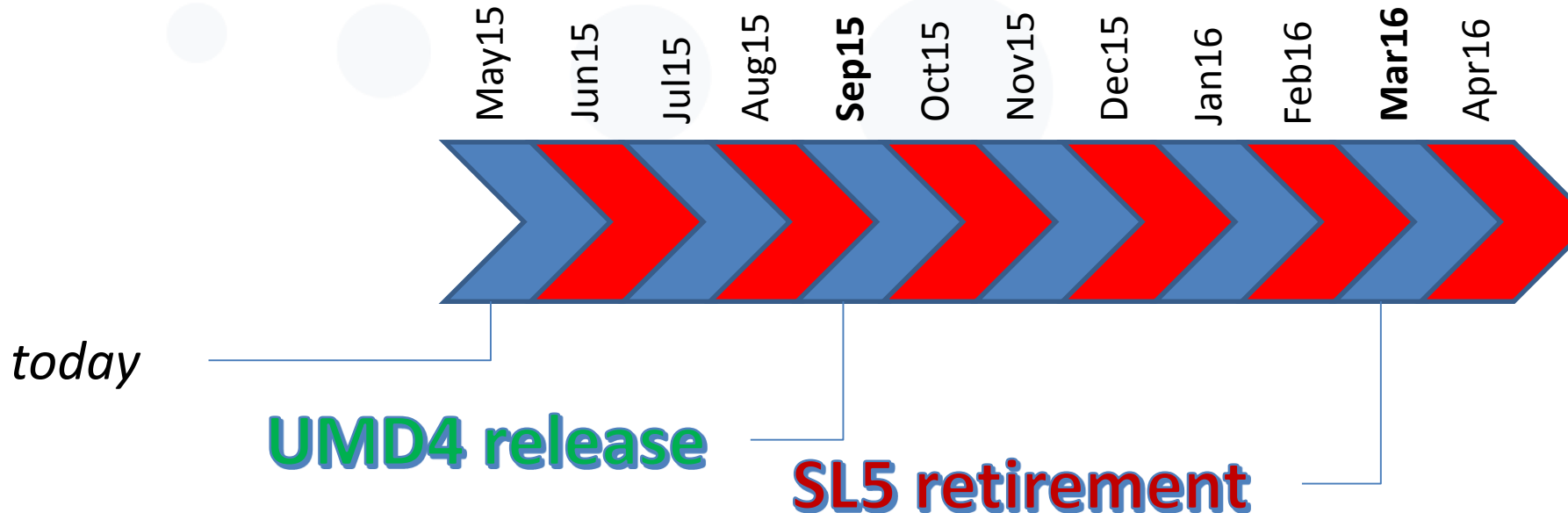


Other Debian-based; 20%



80% of Deb-based sites prefer Ubuntu

- UMD4 → EPEL7, Ubuntu
 - SL6 can be added if major releases are backward incompatible
- UMD3 → SL6, SL5
 - SL5 will provide only security updates after September 2015
- Release of UMD4: **SEPTEMBER 2015**
- Decommission of SL5: **MARCH 2016**
