Where are we now?



- Right in the middle of moving to SourceForge:
 - * Access is slow especially when using SVN 'externals'. are we still in time for evaluating a different repository solution? I think there's also a resource problem over there.
 - Build tools prototype heavily relying on externals is too slow: Luis's solution with tag discriminators seems a better alternative.
 - → make TAG=foo rpm takes care of checking out and build
 - → I still haven't investigated the impact on the BT (complexity already incresead to support SVN).
 - → I'll try to implement it after the workshop.

Next release



- □ Release 1.4-1 is under way:
 - * CDB vs panc-8 bug blocking, I hope to solve it as soon as I'm back.
 - → Else will release with warning...
 - SL(C)3 no longer supported.
- Release 1.4-2 or directly 1.5 should support SL5 and derivates:
 - Please report on SL5 usage.
- Strategy for future releases:
 - I'm setting up a build environment at CNAF.
 - * Keep on providing semestral snapshots:
 - → IMO, a reference for anyone starting from scratches.

Open issues



- My contract ends in three months: someone else should start looking at managing releases.
 - A procedure exists, so it shouldn't be too difficult :-)
