

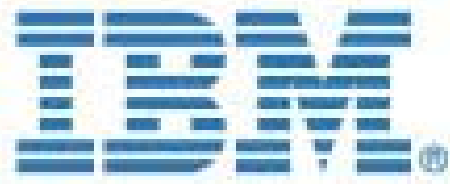

Event Planning

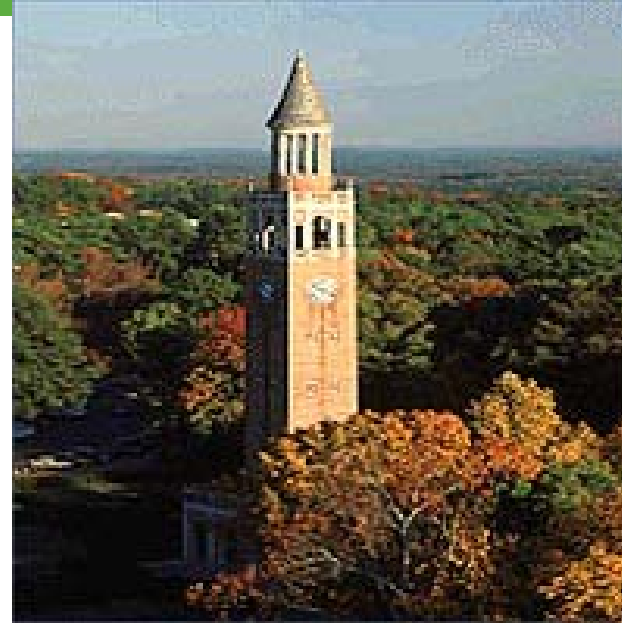


- Results of Event Survey
