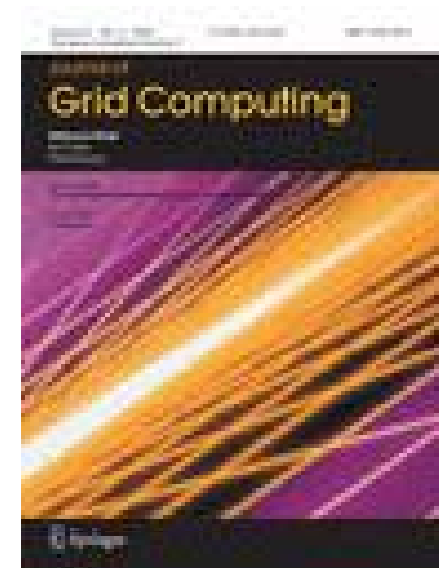
Journal of Grid Computing Special Issue: "EGEE applications and supporting technologies"
