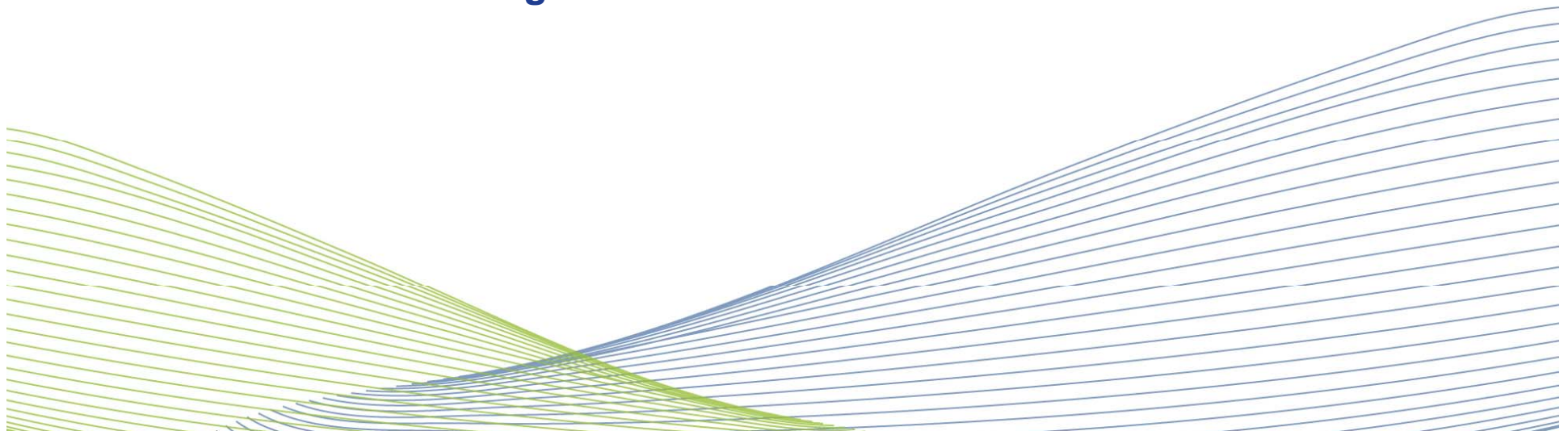





Welcome to the ETICS portal!

ETICS stands for "eInfrastructure for Testing, Integration and Configuration of Software". It provides a service to help software developers, managers and users to better manage complexity and improve the quality of their software. The service allows to fully automate the way a software is built and tested. It provides "out-of-the-box" build and test system, powered with a product repository.

ETICS portal is your entry point to the ETICS system. The portal has been divided into panels that corresponds to different system areas - they have been pictured as tabs on the top of the page. Feel free to maneuver between them by simply clicking on the tab title. It is not recommended to use *back*, *forward*, *refresh* buttons in the browser.

News and announcements 

New ETICS Client v. 1.4.4-1 has been released [2009-02-11]
This release fixes a critical bug found after the release of v. 1.4.3-1 that prevents from using multiple versions of the same dependency within the same build (via the use of static or locally defined dependencies different from those specified by the project)

New ETICS Client v. 1.4.3-1 has been released [2009-01-29]
This release fixes a critical bug found after the release of v. 1.4.2-1 that prevents the chrpath plugin from running correctly

New ETICS Client v. 1.4.2-1 has been released [2009-01-27]
This new version of the client fixes a number of bugs found after the release of the 1.4.0. In addition, support has been added for installation on Debian 64bit and the build reports have been modified to show also unresolved dependencies as failures. Finally, the client log file is now called etics.log and not log.xml anymore since it's not an xml file
