Draft Mandate

The HTASC Videoconferencing Subgroup should advise HTASC and HEPCCC on current and future needs for videoconferencing within the HEP community. For this purpose the current situation with respect to available technologies and trends as well as usage profiles should be reviewed. From this review the group should

- Make recommendations concerning coordination between different laboratories and institutes,
- Develop guidelines for future videoconferencing installations,
- Estimate resources required in order to implement those guidelines.

The group should report back to HTASC and HEPCCC within no more than one year.
