- Problems
 - Unit tests are not enough
 - WP3 testbed is currently too small to find some of our problems
 - Delays in getting things installed
- Solutions
 - Unit tests are cheap – so write a lot
 - Should we go for less sites but with multiple CE and SE per site?
 - We need the resilience framework.
 - Don't introduce a major change before a previous one has been fully tested on a significant testbed.
 - Don't release code just before going on holiday
