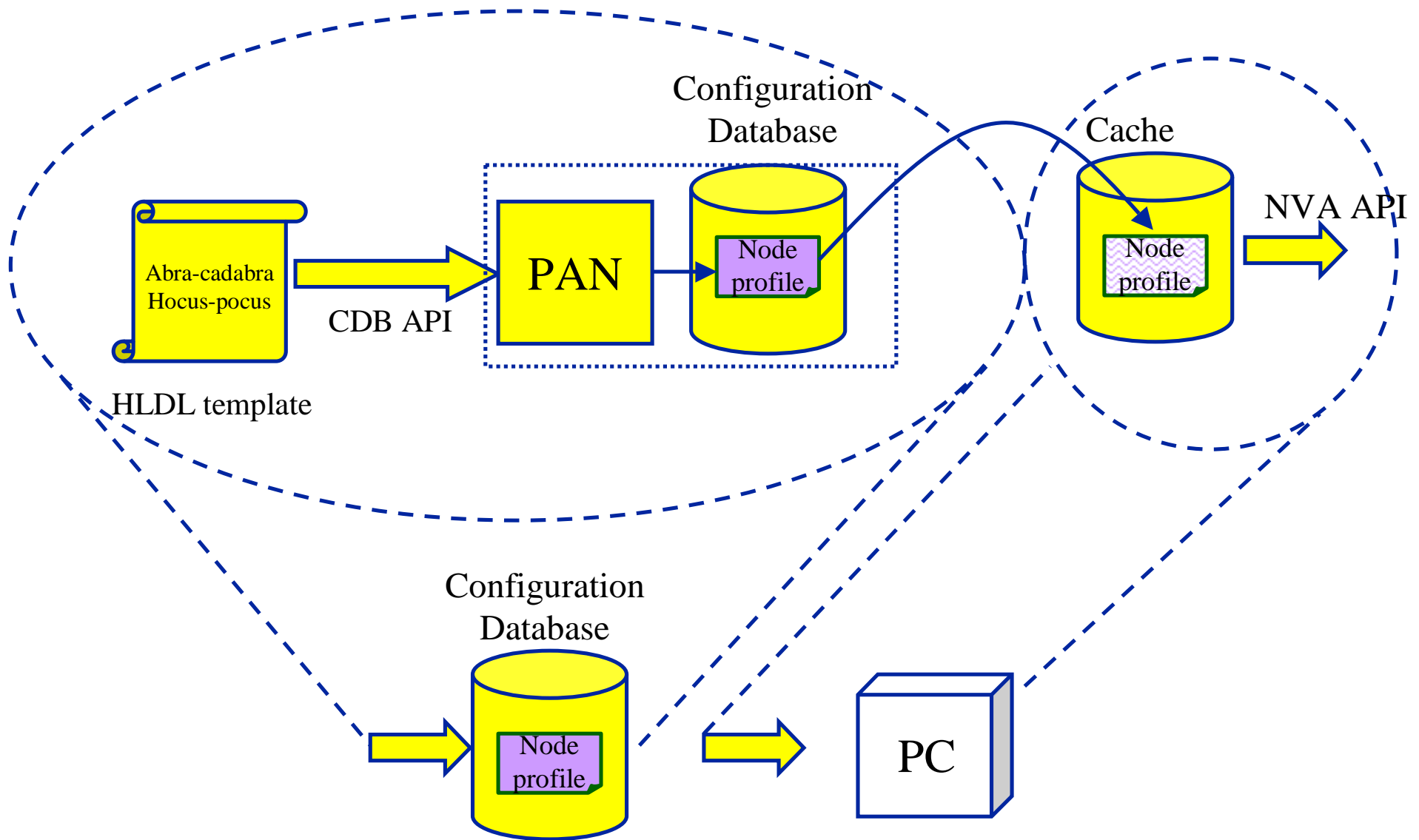
## Olof vision vs reality today

NOTE: components not finished yet are marked in red.

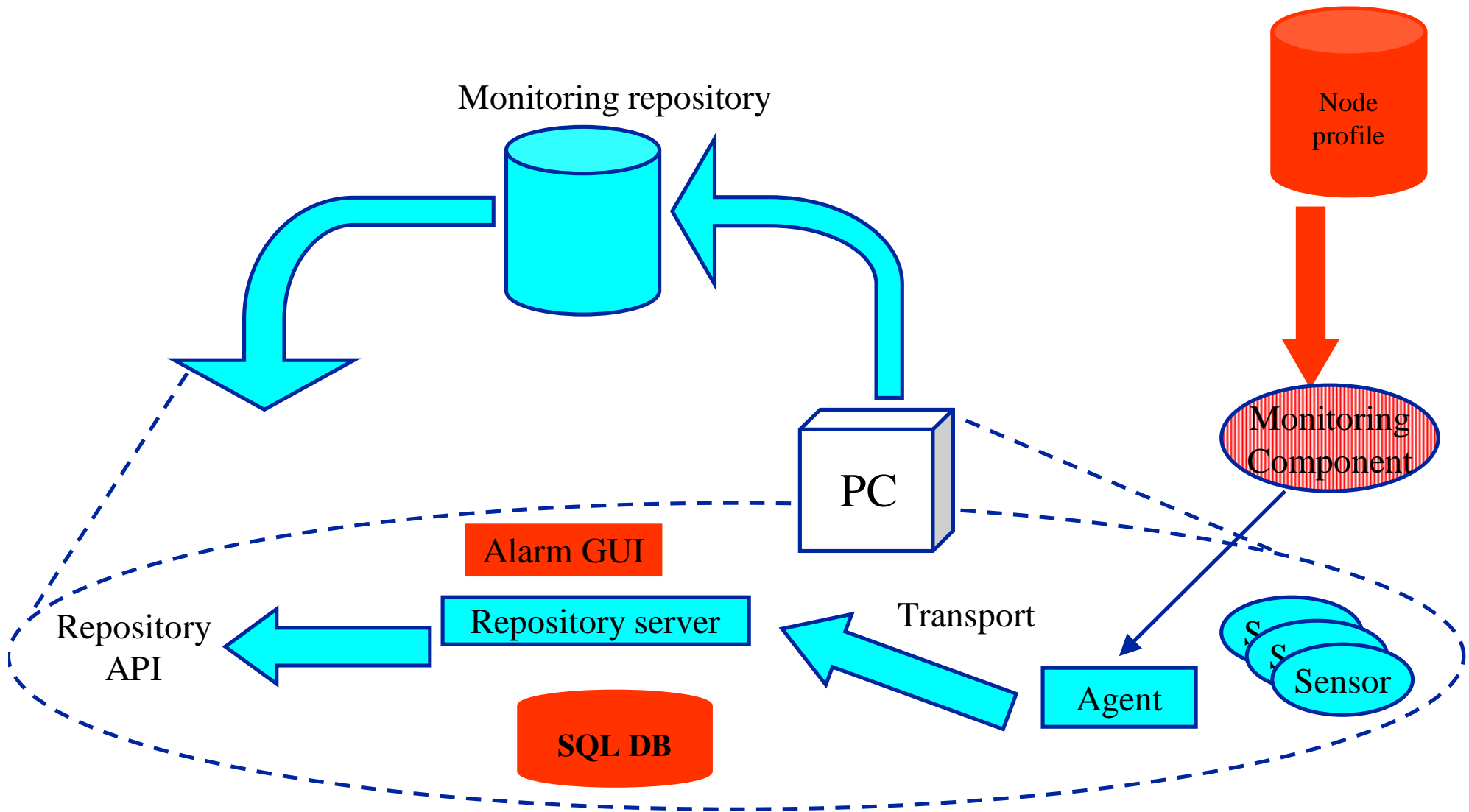


# Configuration today



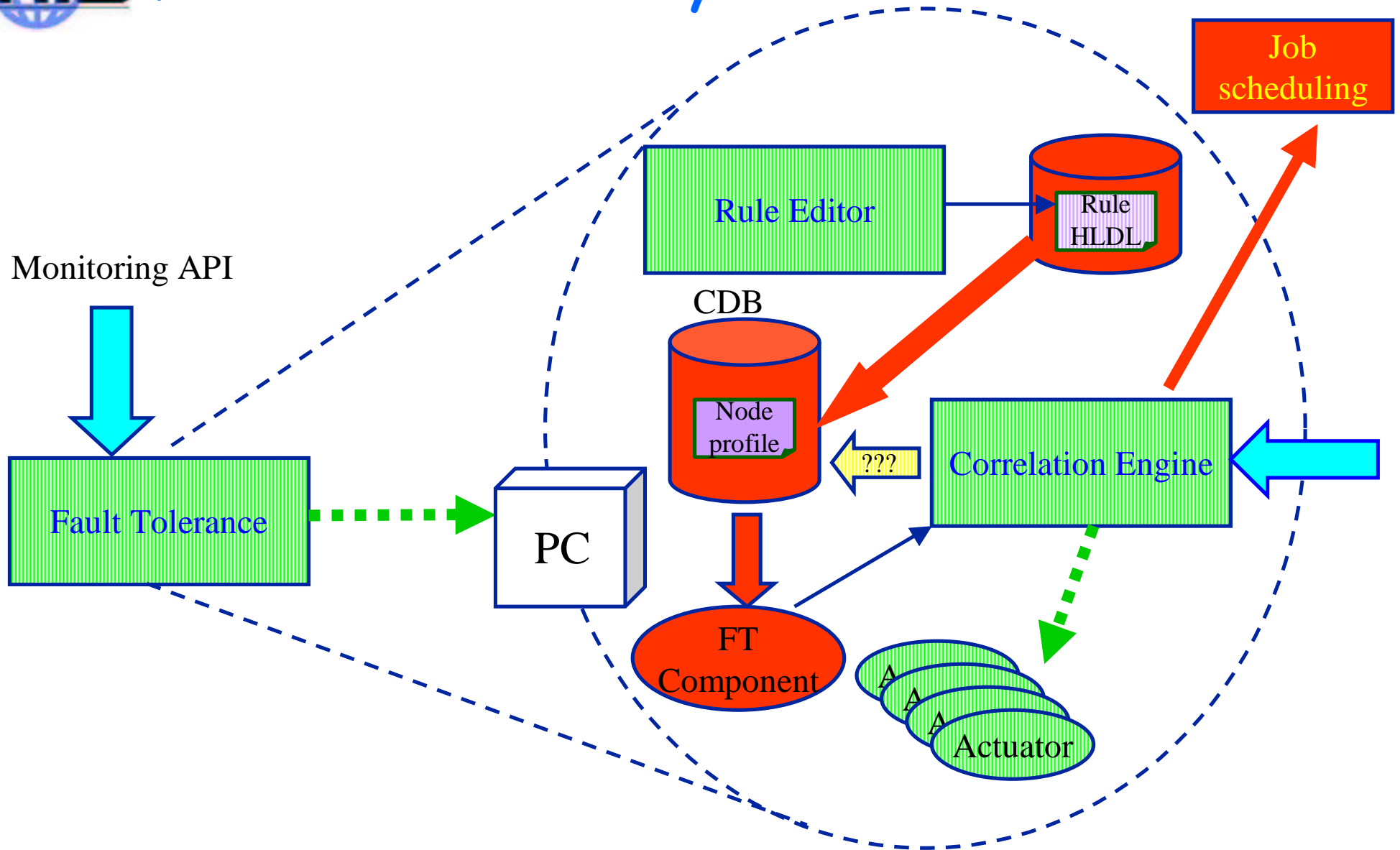


# Monitoring today



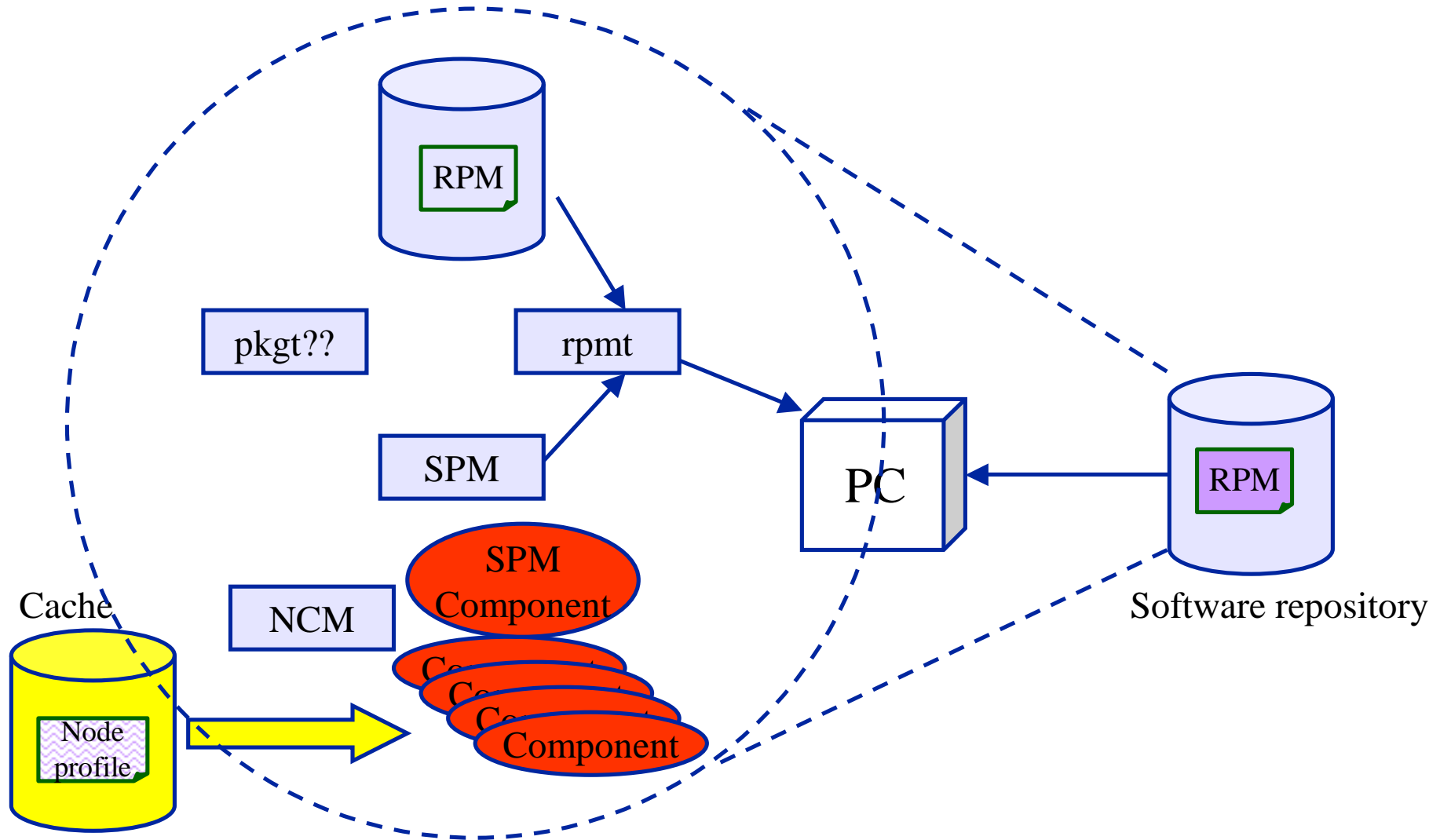


# Fault tolerance today



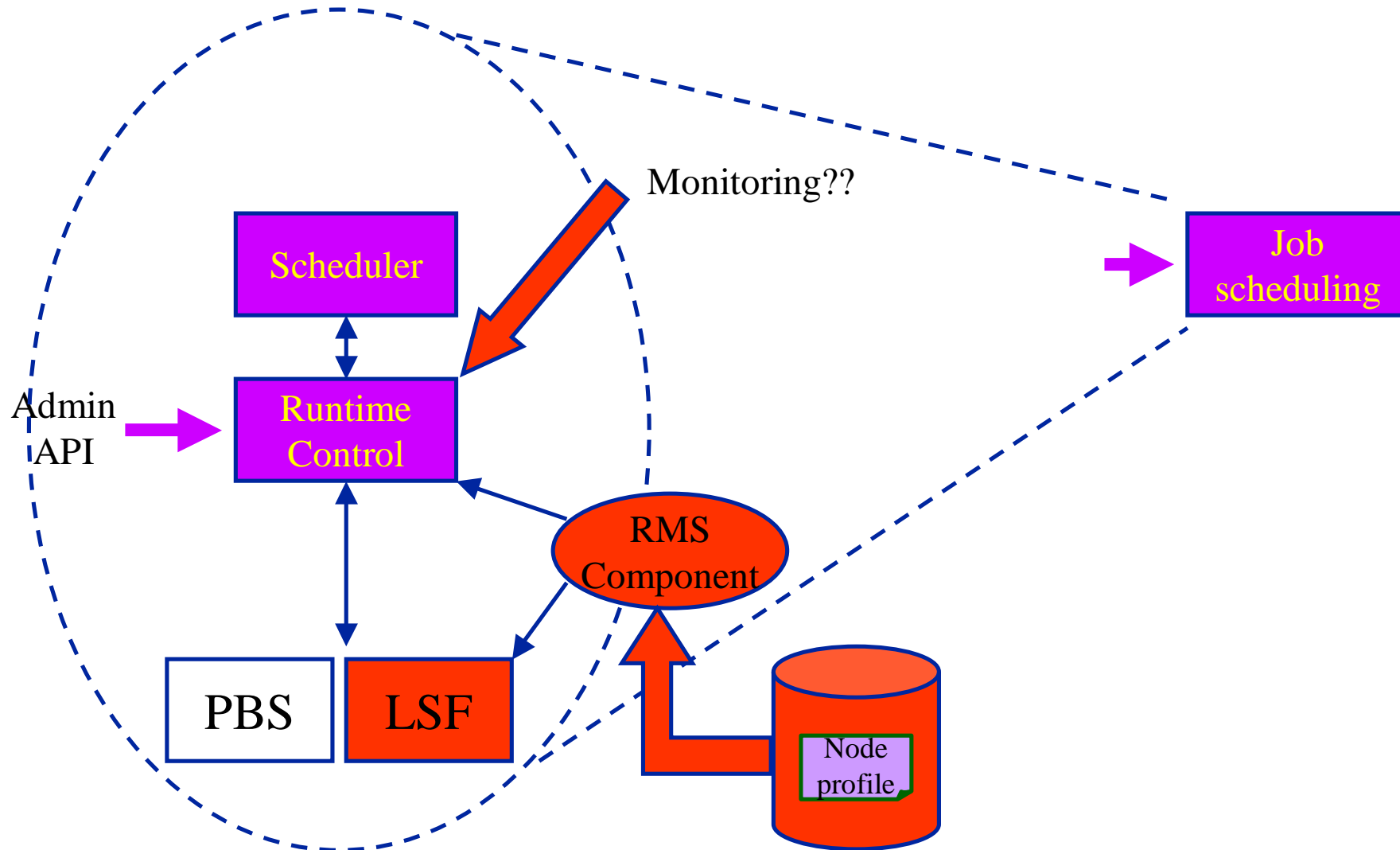

## DISCUSSION: What happens to EDG software after the lifetime of EDG?

- ◆ **GOAL:** finding a single strategy that can be deployed independently of whether related projects (EGEE, LCG) will take over EDG software or not
- ◆ EDG license allows anybody to use EDG software and further develop it as long as EDG is appropriately credited. This model allows other projects to take over EDG software
- ◆ There was consensus that no separate body should be put in place to continue branding EDG.
- ◆ **PROPOSAL:** to make EDG software publicly available in well known software repositories such as sourceforge.
- ◆ EDG license guarantees source code distribution and re-use, EDG design can only be protected by patenting. It is too late for this.
