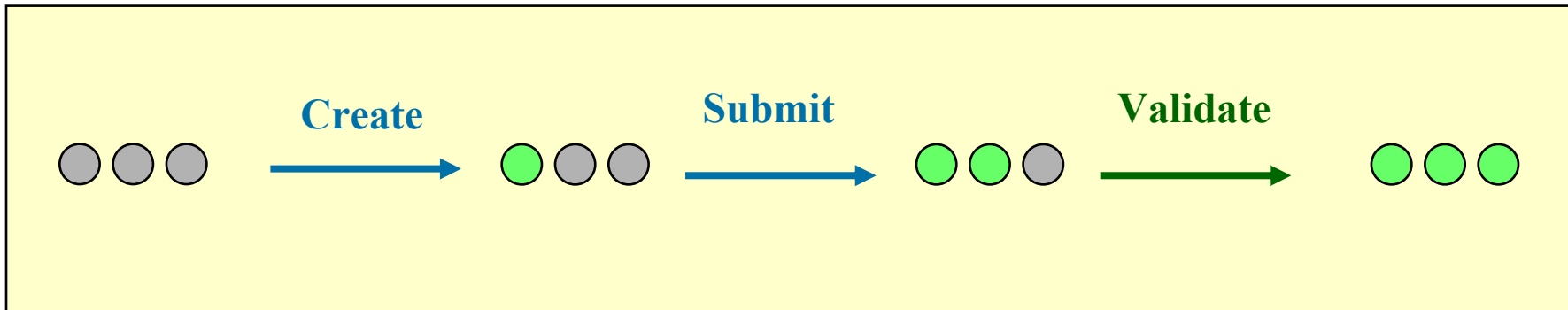

# Timesheet Lifecycle



## Other Examples:



Timesheet was created but not submitted by  $M + S$



Timesheet was submitted but not validated by  $M + V$

$M$  = month end

$S$  = deadline for submission (2)

$V$  = deadline for validation (5)

- October: start usual TimeSheet reporting with PPT/EGEE



- Planned Value: One or many partners work on a task for a planned number of Person-Months.
- Actual Cost: Timesheets indicate hours worked for a task.
- Earned Value: Requires “Progress Reporting”, ie indicate completion level for task.
  - Earned Value by Partner, by Activity...
  - Schedule & Cost Variance for an EU Deliverable ...
