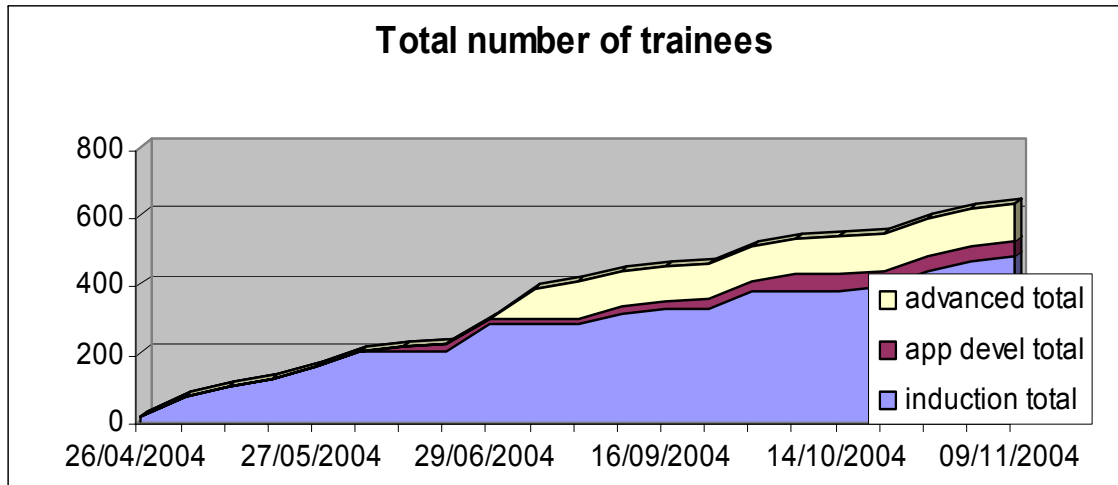

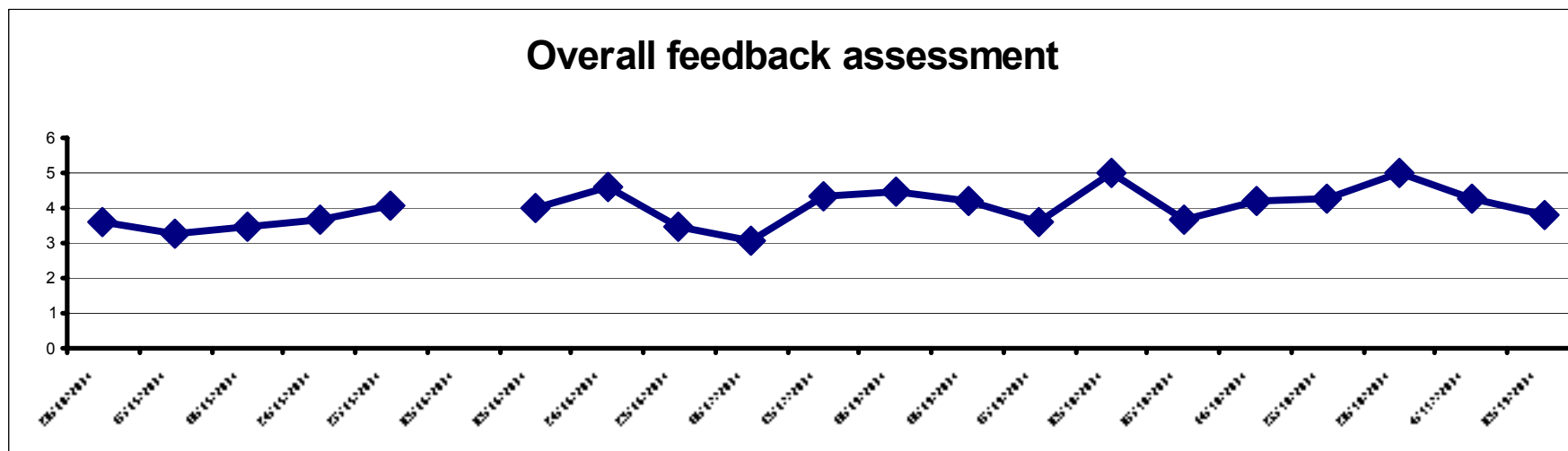
NA3 current issues overview

EGEE training progress (Nov '04)



EGEE NA3 has trained 636 people in 39 courses ranging from introductions to EGEE (induction) through Application Developer to Advanced level.



Meeting NA3 TA targets

Targets for year 1, **but demand exceeds original estimates**

Course type	No of Attendees	% of target	No of courses	% of target
Induction	479	95.8	14	140
Application Developer	48	24	5	62.5
Advanced	109	200	4	200
Technical Activity Retreats	?	?	2(?)	33.33 (?)

Total trained 636 so far. 2 year target 1500, so a bit over 1/3rd

 - Some NA3 sites are trying pre-production gLite to develop courses

 - Preliminary courses with JRA1 in Q1/Q2
 - Courses co-located with & before EGEE conference 3
 - Plan intensive delivery gLite courses
 - Q3 & Q4 2005 across Europe
