

New cert path checking

Enabling Grids for E-sciencE

- Mostly rewritten cert path checking
- Namespace checking
 - Prefers EUGridPMA .namespaces
 - Supports globus .signing_policies
- Slightly more performant
 - Speedup was pretty much eaten by namespace cheking
- Can handle finally other than .0 CA certs and .r0 crls
- Periodic polling for changes in (before only CRLs)
 - CAs, Namespaces, CRLs
- Still missing certificate extension checking
- Tomcat configuration change needed



Proxy Generator

Enabling Grids for E-science

- Easy to use generator for legacy and RFC 3820 certificates
- Support for setting policies in RFC 3820 proxies e.g:
 - Limited proxy, inherit-all, independent
- New supported extensions:
 - Informal proxy tracking extension (from to urls)
 - To restriction (only allowed to be used to authenticate to a set IP space)
 - From restriction (only allowed to be used to authenticate from a set of IP addresses)
 - Do we need one for job ID/CREAM secret?
- Still being developed/tested



Repackaging plan

Enabling Grids for E-sciencE

- Splitting tomcat plugin out of the trustmanager
 - Trustmanger-tomcat.jar only needed for tomcat installation
- Splitting Axis plugin out or trustmanager and util-java
 - Trustmanager-axis.jar only needed by webapps and clients
 - Tomcat needed during build to get servlet-api.jar
- Axis2 plugin is already separate
