



EGEE Sponsor's package for the First EGEE-II Conference to be held in Geneva on September 25-29, 2006

Venue: CIGG, the newly renovated Geneva International Convention Centre, close to United Nations.

Dates: 25-29 September, 2006

Expected number of delegates: 500-600

The EGEE project (Enabling grids for E-science) is a European Union funded effort to build a multi-science, production quality Grid infrastructure. With over 70 partners in 32 countries, it has built the largest Grid infrastructure of its kind in the world. This infrastructure, spanning more than 160 sites and 17,000 CPUs, supports a large number of applications from various scientific domains, including Earth Sciences, High Energy Physics, Biomedical science and Astrophysics

The conference in Geneva will be the first conference of EGEE-II, the second phase of the EGEE program. The two last conferences were held in Athens (454 delegates) and Pisa (461 delegates). The Geneva conference will feature keynote speakers from European Governments, industry and the international research community. EU Commissioner Vivianne Redding and the CERN General Director, Dr Robert Aymar, have also been invited to speak at the conference.

Our conferences also highlight the connections EGEE-II has with the large range of other related efforts supported by the project, as well as the many different user communities who use its infrastructure. Both of these groups will feature prominently at the conference, both in plenary and parallel sessions. Facing many new challenges in the second phase of the project, we will attract an even broader audience than that seen at previous EGEE conferences. Other Geneva-based international organizations will also be invited to take part in the conference. This will allow them to learn more about the grid technology and its potential for areas such as neglected diseases and easing the Digital Divide.

As in all of our conferences, industry plays a prominent and visible role in the program, which allows industry leaders from many different areas to give feedback to the project and help EGEE-II shape the Grid to industrial needs. The program will also feature participation from the CERN openlab, which is now affiliated with EGEE-II.
