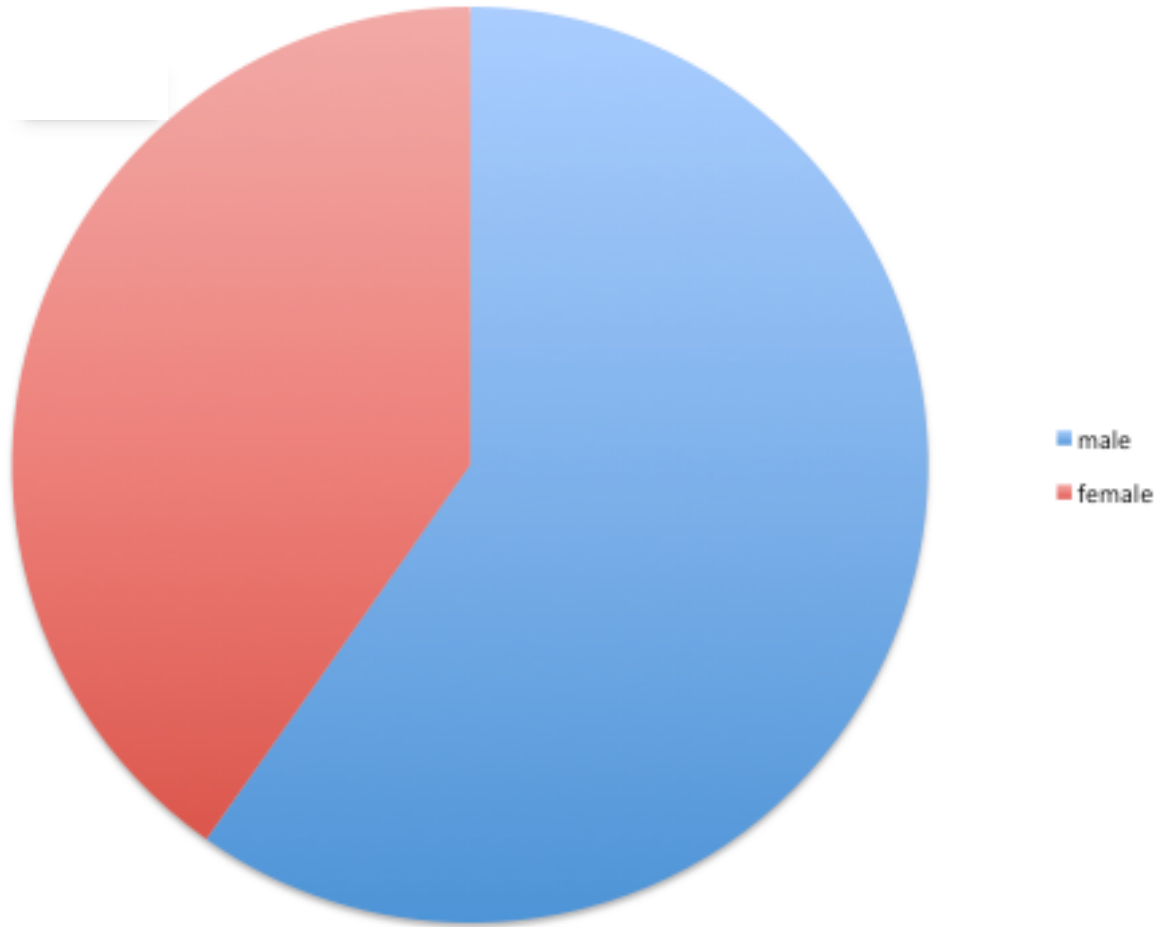
Achievements
