

Formalize the procedure

- LHC BLM threshold ECRs are handled by BL section
 - contrary to the hardware ECRs which are called "-EC" and handled by Samy
 - BLM expert decides whether to follow procedure A or B
- A. Procedure for scheduled changes. Once the change to be implemented is decided on:
 - Write ECR (input from all concerned teams) (1+ days)
 - 2. Circulate amongst authors (2-3 days)
 - 3. Circulate for approval (2-3 days)
 - 4. Close approval procedure and implement changes (1 day)
 - 5. Potentially re-circulate for approval
 - 6. When approved by LMC and the typically 3 responsible persons: implement
- A. Procedure for minor, not-scheduled changes:
 - 1. Get approval (email, verbal etc.) by rMPP
 - 2. Implement
 - 3. Write ECR (as above)
 - 4. Potentially present at LMC



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
