The Commission on Particles and Fields (C11) of IUPAP solicits nominations of outstanding young experimental or theoretical particle physicists for the two 2014 Young Scientists Prizes.

The prizes, each consisting of an IUPAP medal and a cash (€1000) award, will be presented at the 38th International Conference on High Energy Physics, Chicago, USA August 3-10, 2016.

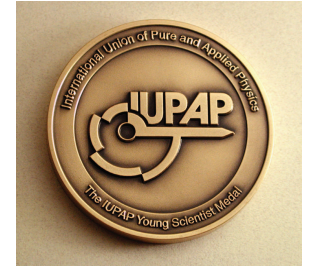
Candidates for the prize should have a maximum of 8 years of research experience (excluding career interruptions) following the PhD. Previous award recipients will not be eligible for the award.

Nominations for the IUPAP Particles and Fields Young Scientist Prize can be made by experimental or theoretical particle physicists who know the work of the nominee well.

Nominations should consist of a minimum of two letters explaining the nominee's qualifications and scientific achievements, a complete CV and a list of publications.

The nomination will open in November 2015 with a deadline of February 1, 2016.

Claude Duhr, IPPP Durham → CERN

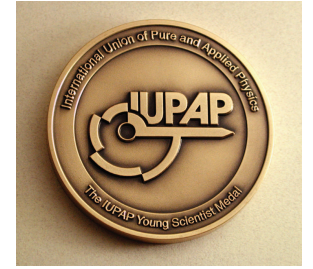
- For his outstanding contributions to elementary particle theory, in particular, to formal developments in quantum field theory and their applications to precision calculations in collider phenomenology.



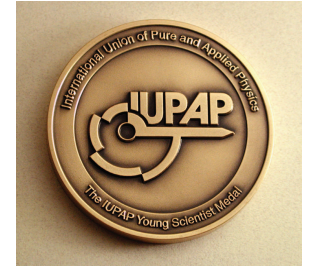
Kerstin Tackmann, DESY/Hamburg

- For her outstanding contributions to experimental high energy physics, in particular, to the discovery of the Higgs Boson via its gamma gamma decay mode with the ATLAS experiment.

# Process



- Advertise – difficult for theorists!
- Use academicjobsonline to collect materials
- Committee members evaluate subsets of applications
- Finalists are reviewed by all
- 1-2 awards made.



# Process from last time
