Where,

- ø is the lunar orbits twist angle (ø=26.92952225).

Speed= distance/time

Speed of light=12000 Lunar Orbits/Earth Day

 $= 12000 L \cos \theta / t$

 $= 12000 \ 2 \ \pi \ R \cos \theta / t$

= 299792.458 km/sec.

Where,

- R is the distance between earth and moon (R=3.738* 10^6 m)
- Earth Day is outside gravitational fields i.e. time for one rotation of Earth about its axis with respect to stars.






